MAJOR OUTAGE WORK: Suncor Base Plant 2022 Spring Maintenance

Pre-work begins in Q1 for select trades, with Feed-out scheduled for May 23, 2022.

Spring Maintenance: Suncor Base Plant is executing a Maintenance Event in Plant 52/98 this spring. About 750 craft are required to execute this project of approximately 330,000 workforce hours.

Craft supporting Critical Path will be on 12-hour shifts; all other workforce will be on 10-hour shifts.

Camp will be provided. Travel Assistance Protocol will be available to secure specific craft.
