SOUTHWEST FLORIDA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT REPORTS SEPTEMBER TRAFFIC

FORT MYERS, Fla. (Oct. 18, 2024) – During September, 523,004 passengers traveled through Southwest Florida International Airport (RSW) in Fort Myers. This was a decrease of 7 percent compared to September 2023. Year-to-date, passenger traffic is up 14 percent.

The traffic leader in September was Delta with 134,592 passengers. Rounding out the top five airlines were Southwest (92,627), United (83,654), American (83,512) and JetBlue (60,121).

Southwest Florida International Airport had 5,597 aircraft operations, an increase of 6 percent compared to September 2023. Page Field saw 13,286 operations, which was a 16 percent decrease compared to September 2023.

Southwest Florida International Airport served more than 10 million passengers in 2023 and is one of the top 50 U.S. airports for passenger traffic. No ad valorem (property) taxes are used for airport operation or construction. For more information, visit flylcpa.com or facebook.com/flyRSW.
