### **RSW TERMINAL EXPANSION PROJECTS ADVISORY #13: CONCOURSE C TEMPORARY CHECKPOINT OPENING & ACCESS**

As part of the work for the Terminal Expansion Project Phase 1 at Southwest Florida International Airport (RSW), the Temporary TSA Security Checkpoint for Concourse C will open over several days starting the **morning of Tuesday, Feb. 3, 2026.**

**Tuesday, Feb. 3 and Wednesday, Feb. 4 - Concourse C will have split operations between the current checkpoint and new Temporary Checkpoint.**

- Only TSA PreCheck passengers will enter the new Temporary Checkpoint from the West Atrium inside Door 5 for security screening.
- All other Concourse C passengers will proceed to the current checkpoint from the East Atrium inside Door 2 for security screening.

**Thursday, Feb. 5 – The Concourse C Temporary Checkpoint will be fully operational and the current checkpoint will close.**

- All passengers for Concourse C will need to enter the new Temporary Checkpoint from the West Atrium inside Door 5. There will no longer be access to Concourse C from the East Atrium inside Door 2.
- All passengers will exit Concourse C into the West Atrium (Door 5, upper level).

**Delta, United and WestJet passengers in Concourse C** need to be aware of these changes when traveling out of RSW starting Feb. 3, 2026. Please note, passengers in Concourses B and D will not be impacted by this change.

It may take a little extra time to navigate through the terminal to Concourse C. Please look for new wayfinding signage posted throughout the terminal and airport customer care associates for assistance. The Lee County Port Authority will continue to post updates on the airport's [website](#) and [Facebook](#) to help travelers and airport users become aware of changes due to construction.

We appreciate your understanding as we increase capacity, airport efficiency and provide passengers with more amenities and options at Southwest Florida International Airport.
