Intro: The Interrogation Room

Questioning Judas.

1) Why would we talk about Judas on Easter?

Because either we are Judas or we are refusing to eat with Judas.

Do you question Jesus vetting skills?

Luke 19:10 - For the Son of man came to seek and to save that which was lost.

2) Jesus not just WELCOMES but ACCEPTS Sinners and is actually a FRIEND of sinners.

John 13:4-5 ESV - 4 [Jesus] rose from supper. He laid aside his outer garments, and taking a towel, tied it around his waist. 5 Then he poured water into a basin and began to wash the disciples' feet and to wipe them with the towel that was wrapped around him.

Jesus has bigger problems than our sin— Jesus has already defeated sin –

It's not that sin is sin because it's bad—SIN is just the opposite of helpful it's destructive

John 10:10 shows us that Jesus came to give life and life to the fullest.

JESUS DIDN'T COME TO MAKE BAD PEOPLE GOOD
JESUS CAME TO GIVE DEAD PEOPLE LIFE.

3) So why did Judas do what He did?.

- Judas was an unbeliever, who betrayed the Jesus.
- Peter was a believer, who denied Jesus.

in the midst of our mess JESUS not just WELCOMES but ACCEPTS Sinners and is actually a FRIEND of sinners but he also CHANGES SINNERS but ONLY if they want to change from who they are into who God has created them to be.

2 Corinthians 5:17 ESV - 17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come.

1 John 4:9-10 NLT - God showed how much he loved us by sending his one and only Son into the world so that we might have eternal life through him. 10 This is real love—not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as a sacrifice to take away our sins.
