Series - The Third Act  
Sermon Title - The Kingdom

Big Idea: The third act of a movie or play completes the story and/or offers resolutions or answers. It ties together the narrative elements that came earlier. Weaknesses shown in the first act are overcome in the climax of the third act. In the same way, Jesus is the climax of the story of Scripture. This week we dive into Jesus' own words in what he was trying to accomplish as the Kingdom of God.

Do we also suffer from "tiny islanditis"?

1. The King that was coming was predicted.

Zechariah 9:9 - 9Rejoice, O people of Zion! Shout in triumph, O people of Jerusalem! Look, your king is coming to you. He is righteous and victorious, yet he is humble, riding on a donkey.

Not just once but 365 times!

The odds of just 8 of them coming true is 1 in 10 to the 17th power (100,000,000,000,000,000)

2. So the Kingdom is here but where is his kingdom?

Mark 4:3-11 - 3"Listen! A farmer went out to plant some seed. 4As he scattered it across his field, some of the seed fell on a footpath, and the birds came and ate it. 5Other seed fell on shallow soil with underlying rock. The seed sprouted quickly because the soil was shallow. 6But the plant soon wilted under the hot sun, and since it didn't have deep roots, it died. 7Other seed fell among thorns that grew up and choked out the tender plants so they produced no grain. 8Still other seeds fell on fertile soil, and they sprouted, grew, and produced a crop that was thirty, sixty, and even a hundred times as much as had been planted!" 9Then he said, "Anyone with ears to hear should listen and understand." 10Later, when Jesus was alone with the twelve disciples and with the others who were gathered around, they asked him what the parables meant. 11He replied, "You are permitted to understand the secret of the Kingdom of God.

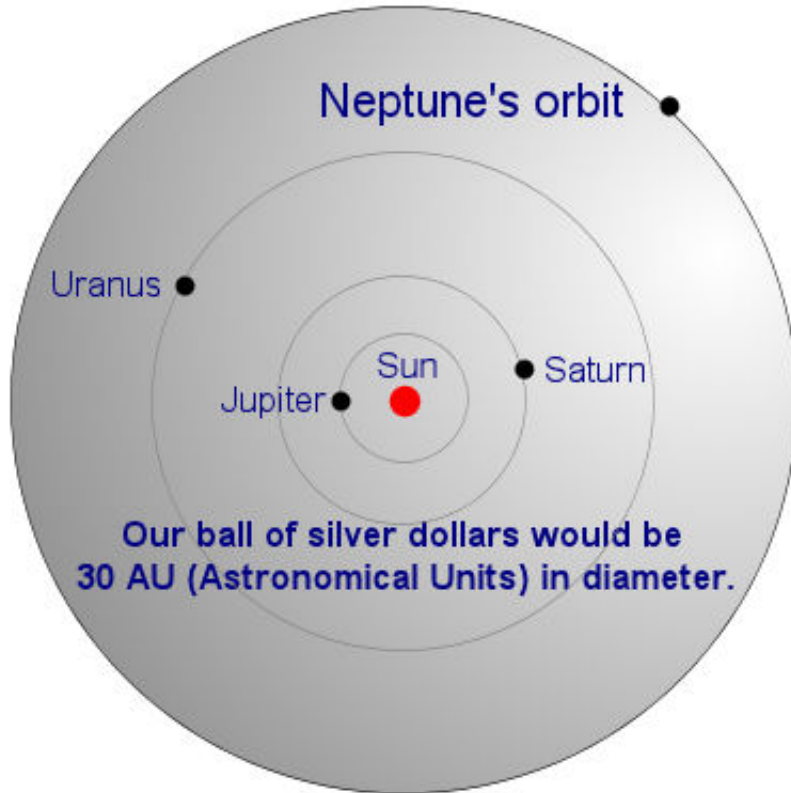
In Jesus' kingdom weapons are not armies with swords, but farmers with seeds.

Three principles of the kingdom of God are:

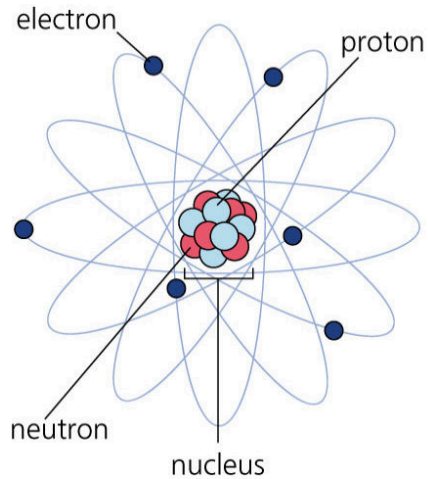
1. The kingdom of God is a great treasure—like a huge, expensive pearl. Matthew 13:44-46
2. The kingdom of God operates with energies we do not understand or control. Mark 4:26-29
3. The kingdom of God is a worry-free, anxiety-free realm. Matthew 6:25-27; Matthew 6:33.

Closing - Now we're in training to live the kingdom life.



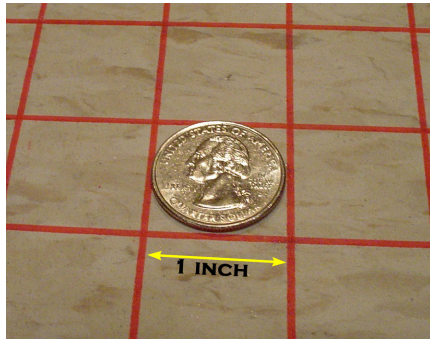


Professor Stoner gives us yet another illustration, but this time, because a silver dollar, and even the atom, would be too large for this one he chose to use just the electron that orbits the nucleus of the atom.



The electron is one of the smallest particles of matter known to man. It is so small that if you

lined up  $2.5 \times 10^{15}$  (2,500,000,000,000,000) single file you would end up with a line that is only 1 inch long. (If we were going to count the electrons in this line one inch long, and counted 250 each minute, and if we counted day and night, it would take us 19,000,000 years to count just the one-inch line of electrons.)



Now back to Stoner's illustration. Using only 48 of the prophecies that Jesus fulfilled it was calculated that the chances of one person fulfilling these by sheer chance would be 1 in  $10^{157}$ .

To help us understand how huge this number is he suggested taking  $10^{157}$  electrons and pressing them into a solid ball. This ball, made entirely of electrons, would pretty much fill, not just our galaxy, but the entire known universe. (At the time Stoner's book was written the universe was known to be at least 6 billion light years in all directions. Stoner's known universe would need to be filled about 10,000,000,000,000,000,000,000,000,000 times.) **Once again we would mark just one electron, blindfold a man and send him out to find that one electron.**

Peter Stoner then states, ***"To the extent, then, that we know this blindfolded man cannot pick out the marked electron, we know that the Bible is inspired. This is not merely evidence. It is proof of the Bible's inspiration by God--proof so definite that the universe is not large enough to hold the evidence."***

Professor Stoner then made the comment that, ***"Any man who rejects Christ as the Son of God is rejecting a fact proved perhaps more absolutely than any other fact in the world."***

And the fact that Jesus had no control over things like where, when and how He was born, or where He was buried just adds to the available evidence that He did not just work to make sure that all of the prophecies were fulfilled so that people would believe Him to be the Messiah.
