## LC3 BELIEFS, STRATEGY, AND STRUCTURE

### BELIEFS

**God** is the Creator and Ruler of the universe. He has eternally existed in three personalities: The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. These three are co-equal and are one God. *Genesis 1:1,26,27, 3:22; Psalm 90:2; Matthew 28:19; 1 Peter 1:2; 2 Corinthians 13:14*

**Jesus Christ** is the Son of God. He is co-equal with the Father. Jesus lived a sinless human life and offered Himself as the perfect sacrifice for the sins of all people by dying on a cross. He arose from the dead after three days to demonstrate His power over sin and death. He ascended to Heaven's glory and will return again someday to earth to reign as King of Kings, and Lord of Lords. *Matthew 1:22, 23; Isaiah 9:6; John 1:1-5; 14:10-30; Hebrews 4:14,15; 1 Corinthians 15:3,4; Romans 1:3,4; Acts 1:9-11; 1 Timothy 6:14,15; Titus 2:13*

**The Holy Spirit** is co-equal with the Father and the Son of God. He is present in the world to make men aware of their need for Jesus Christ. He also lives in every Christian from the moment of salvation. He provides the Christian with power for living, understanding of spiritual truth, and guidance in doing what is right. He gives every believer a spiritual gift when they are saved. As Christians, we seek to live under His control daily. *2 Corinthians 3:17; John 16:7-13, 14:16,17; Acts 1:8; 1 Corinthians 2:12, 3:16; Ephesians 1:13, 5:18; Galatians 5:25*

**The Bible** is God's Word to us. It was written by human authors, under the supernatural guidance of the Holy Spirit. It is the supreme source of truth for Christian beliefs and living. Because it is inspired by God, it is the truth without any mixture of error. *2 Timothy 3:16; 2 Peter 1:20,21; 2 Timothy 1:13; Psalm 119:105,160, 12:6; Proverbs 30:5*

**Human beings** are made in the spiritual image of God, to be like Him in character. People are the supreme object of God's creation. Although every person has tremendous potential for good, all of us are marred by an attitude of disobedience toward God called "sin." This attitude separates people from God and causes many problems in life. *Genesis 1:27; Psalm 8:3-6; Isaiah 53:6a; Romans 3:23; Isaiah 59:1, 2*

**Salvation** is God's free gift to us, but we must accept it. We can never make up for our sin by self-improvement or good works. Only by trusting in Jesus Christ as God's offer of forgiveness can anyone be saved from sin's penalty. When we turn from our self-ruled life and turn to Jesus in faith, we are saved. Eternal life begins the moment one receives Jesus Christ into his life by faith. *Romans 6:23; Ephesians 2:8,9; John 14:6, 1:12; Titus 3:5; Galatians 3:26; Romans 5:1*

**Eternal security** is solely possible through Jesus Christ. Because God gives us eternal life through Jesus Christ, the true believer is secure in that salvation for eternity. If you have been genuinely saved, you cannot "lose" it. Salvation is maintained by the grace and power of God, not by the self-effort of the Christian. It is the grace and keeping power of God that gives us this security. *John 10:29; 2 Timothy 1:12; Hebrews 7:25, 10:10,14; 1 Peter 1:3-5*

**Heaven and Hell** are real places of eternal existence. People were created to exist forever. We will either exist eternally separated from God by sin, or eternally with God through forgiveness and salvation. To be eternally separated from God is Hell. To be eternally in union with Him is eternal life. *John 3:16, John 14:17; Romans 6:23; Romans 8:17-18; Revelation 20:15; 1 Cor. 2:7-9*

**Baptism** is the immersion of a believer in water in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. It is an act of obedience symbolizing the believer's faith in a crucified, buried, and risen Savior, the believer's death to sin, the burial of the old life, and the resurrection to walk in newness of life in Christ Jesus. *Matthew 3:16*

**The Lord's Supper** is a symbolic act of obedience whereby believers, through partaking of the bread and the fruit of the vine, memorialize the death of the Redeemer and anticipate His second coming. *Matthew 26:26-30*

## **STRATEGY**

### **ALIGNMENT *Everyone Pulling in the Same Direction***

Alignment simply means everyone pulling in the same direction. Disunity causes confusion, wastes energy, and limits effectiveness. Our goal is for LC3 CHURCH to be both unified as believers and aligned with God's purpose for our church. Different churches appeal to different people. That doesn't mean that one is right and the other wrong, it just means that they're different. If LC3 CHURCH is not your particular flavor or style, no hard feelings. In fact, we would love to help you find a church that better fits you.

### **INVOLVEMENT *Belong and Contribute***

LC3 CHURCH is not a place to just sit and watch. No matter where you are on your spiritual journey, we have a place for you to belong and contribute. You were crafted with a purpose. Your passions, abilities, and experiences uniquely qualify you for a specific role in the kingdom of God. When you become a part of LC3 Church, we'll help you find what that is. Imagine being part of a church where you can discover your calling and be used by God to bless others. That is LC3 CHURCH. Together, there is no limit to what God can do through us. *NO ONE CAN DO WHAT YOU DO THE WAY YOU DO IT!*

### **CHANGE *Healthy things grow and growing things change***

Healthy things grow, and growing things change. If you are resistant to change, then LC3 CHURCH is probably not the place for you. Our church will never be static, not now or 20 years from now. As culture evolves and our church grows, we may alter the methods, but **we will never change the message**. An openness to change is deeply ingrained in our identity and philosophy. LC3 CHURCH is all about building bridges with other believers, churches, and our community to make an eternal difference. It's time for the body of Christ to work together.

### **ADVENTURE *Take Spirit-Led Risks***

It's tragic that so many Christians reduce their relationships with God down to a set of mundane rituals, and unimaginative routines. The Christian life should be an exhilarating quest...a fulfilling adventure. Jesus doesn't call you to play it safe...He calls you to live on the edge! Taking calculated, spirit-led risk is, and always will be, a part of our DNA. The God of the universe has called us to take part in His mission. We invite you to join us on the adventure of a lifetime.

### **MULTIPLICATION *Make Disciples***

In Acts 1:8 as Jesus sent His disciples out to reach a disconnected culture He said, "You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." Jesus Himself set up a model for multiplication that we follow still today. LC3 Church will always be a church that is focused on reproducing leaders, planting churches, and spreading the gospel. Igniting a movement happens through multiplication!

### **DIVERSITY *We are Better Together***

We don't just tolerate our differences; we celebrate them and fight for unity in the midst of diversity. In our world, there is so much polarization and divide. Now more than ever it is critical for the body of Jesus — the local church — to exemplify His mission to bring together all people and celebrate the uniqueness He designed us with. God calls us to come together in our diversity and build His church in His image, from every tribe, tongue and nation (Revelation 7:9).

## **STRUCTURE**

LC3 Church is a senior pastor-led, elder-governed, congregation-owned, volunteer- and staff-run church. The partnership is annually informed of ministry results and financial details of the ministry operations.

Steve Fairchild is our Senior Pastor and serves as the head of our leadership team. As such, he is focused on leading LC3 Church through inspired vision, direction and preaching of God's Word. Peter Milosky serves as the LC3 Operations Pastor and is responsible for implementing the vision of the church through the anointed team of men and women whom God has assembled to conduct ministry through many different ministries and departments. Austin Bond serves as the LC3 Youth Pastor and Worship Pastor and is responsible for fostering Christian community through building relationships with young people, strengthening their commitment to the church and growth in their faith walk and helps to develop a worship culture that is biblically based and leads people to a greater understanding of worship and to fully experience the presence of God.

The Elder Board is the governing body of the church. Vision and direction for the ministries of the church are confirmed through Elder prayer and oversight. Structure is based on a model of singular headship by the Senior Pastor along with input from the plurality of Elders (following the model established in Exodus 18).

Deacons Overseers are those who by gifting and calling fulfill a service responsibility to the congregation. Deacons Overseers are servants first. Deacon Overseers' service is not intended to be a training ground for Elder service. As described in Scripture, deacon Overseer service requires spiritually mature, servant-minded believers and carries its own rewards.

Together, our team is focused on God, and we're committed to serving you and your family as the primary work of building a great local church.

LC3 is a nondenominational, Spirit-empowered church. As a nondenominational church, we are evangelical, focusing on biblical teaching and preaching more than church tradition as the guide to church behavior. Being a nondenominational church allows the leadership of LC3 to govern the church based on sensitivity to God's leading and direction regarding vision, budgets, policies, formal standards and needs-based ministry.

Another characteristic of a nondenominational church relates to control of church assets. LC3's assets are owned by the congregation and administered by the staff and Elders, rather than by a centralized denomination. The vision and direction of the church, along with the church's standards for leadership, partnership and the Statement of Faith, are determined by the Elder Board.

We acknowledge there is one universal Church referred to as the body of Christ of which LC3 is a part. God's work through His body extends through all congregations, as well as denominations, committed to Him. We relate within the body of Christ based on the unity of faith and commitment we have to Christ. We openly embrace all those who love Christ and work for His kingdom. We focus our interchurch relationships on what we have in common and not doctrinal differences or biblical interpretations. We come together as much as possible with other congregations for the benefit of God's kingdom in our community and around the world.

While we believe in the importance of being a self-governing local church, we also believe in the importance of accountability. LC3 Church has established relational accountability with other churches and ministries to serve as an important source of wisdom and perspective as we seek God's direction for our church.
