#### Going Deeper

Re-read James 5:1-6

How do you think our passage relates to the verses that precede it? That follow it?

This is a hard passage. When you encounter passages like this in Scripture, what is typically your response? Why?

Read James 5:1. What is the first command James gives to these rich people?

These rich landowners who mistreated others are told to “*weep and wail*” over their injustices. Are there injustices that cause you to cry out in anguish over the mistreatment you see? What can you do about these things?

Have you ever been mistreated as a worker? How did that make you feel? What action could you take to remedy the situation? Would an advocate have made it easier to seek justice?

Have you ever used your power or status for your advantage over others of lesser status? Explain

Read Mark 10:43-45. Everything Jesus did was to model to His disciples and to us how we should live. Jesus came to serve, so that should be our mindset as well. How can you serve those who are in lesser positions or are under your leadership?

Do you spend more time focusing on your earthly riches or on the riches to come in heaven? Why?

What are the ways that we can better use our resources for God's kingdom instead of our own?
