These were the words God's prophet spoke to King Asa. Asa had been a good king, but toward the end of his reign he became so self-confident that he neglected seeking the Lord or depending upon him. Asa's circumstances may have been different from ours, but the principle remains. God wants us to trust him, to depend upon him, and to love him with all of our hearts. He stands ready and willing to reveal himself to anyone who truly seeks him.

God is searching. Has he found in you a heart that is completely his? He notices our hearts. He is able to interpret our actions and motives. Nothing escapes his attention.

Think of the blessings God wants to pour out on us, but our lack of faith prevents us from experiencing them. The prophet was saying to Asa, God has blessed you in the past and wants to bless you more, but your faithlessness has prevented him from doing so.


