Going Deeper

Re-read [Luke 5:1-11](#). Try reading this passage in *a harmony of the gospels*. You can find one online if you don't own one. What stands out to you? What's your take on this?

What stood out to you in our passage? Share your thoughts and observations with your group.

Read Matthew 4:13-16 to find out what Jesus did after His time in Nazareth.

What previous encounters had Peter and the other disciples had with Jesus before our present passage? How do you see those previous experiences influencing what we read in Luke 5?

When's the last time you were Done - physically, emotionally, or spiritually? What happened? How did your experience resolve? Has it resolved? Did you learn anything from our lesson that would be applicable or helpful for this resolution?

What are some other examples in the gospels of Jesus or the disciples being Done, or at least times when you would expect them to be Done? Discuss as a group.

Are you learning to see times when Satan is attacking you as also an opportunity for God to do something miraculous in your life? How can you commit yourself to God and His plan more fully during these times?

What in your life right now doesn't make sense? How can you allow this experience to push you deeper in your relationship with Jesus?

What is *faith*? Read [Hebrews 11:1](#) and discuss as a group. How does faith relate to the things in our life that don't make sense?

Have you ever gone somewhere (physically, emotionally, relationally, spiritually...) outside of your comfort zone where you witnessed God do something miraculous? What happened? What did this experience teach you?

What's the *"this makes no sense, but because you say so Lord, I'll do it!"* in your life right now?

In your opinion, what's the difference between this story (with the nets breaking) and the story in [John 21](#) (where the nets don't break)? What do you think the nets represent? What's the difference?

What's one way that you can practice what you've learned?
