


A Samaritan Woman is Thankful

John 4:1-26

One day Jesus and his disciples were walking through a land called Samaria. When he came to the town, Jesus decided to stop by a well to rest. While he was resting a Samaritan woman came to the well to get some water, and Jesus asked her if she would give Him a drink. She was surprised that He would even talk to her because she did not know who Jesus was. Jesus answered her, “If you knew the gift of God and who it is that asks you for a drink, you would have asked him and he would have given you living water.” The woman noticed that Jesus did not have a vase for the water, so she asked Him where to get the living water. Jesus explained to the Samaritan woman that anybody who drinks of the water from this earthly well will not be satisfied, but if they drink the living water they will never be thirsty again. He said, “The water I give them will become in them a spring of water welling up to eternal life.” Jesus was using water as an example. Like water satisfies the body, a relationship with Jesus satisfies the soul.
