Notes for the Preaching of God's Word

Robed in the Righteousness of God: The Vision of the High Priest and Pure Vestments Zechariah 3:1-10

Main Preaching Point: By the sufficient and saving grace of God through the priestly work of Jesus Christ, he has removed our guilt and old nature, and robed us in His righteousness.

- > The Sin of Man: Covered in Iniquity
- ➤ The Need for Intercession: The High Priest
- ➤ The Righteousness of God: Robed in Holiness

Questions for Individuals, families, or small groups

Text: Zechariah 3:1-10

Title: Robed in the Righteousness of God: The Vision of the

High Priest and Pure Vestments

Questions:

1. What was most important or applicable in today's preaching? Can you summarize the main message?

The Sin of Man: Covered in Iniquity

- 2. Discuss the overall context of the book of Zechariah. When is this prophet ministering? How does it relate to the exile and time of restoration? Read Zechariah 3:1-3. According to the sermon how do the 4th and 5th visions (focusing on Joshua and Zerubbabel) differ than the first three visions? Also read Ezra 2:2.
- 3. What overall role does the high priest have? How does it relate to the holy presence of God and how God's people might draw near to the Lord?

- According to the sermon how does the high priest's ministry relate to the Day of Atonement recorded in Leviticus 16?
- 4. What is the problem that Joshua (and all God's people) face, according to verse 3? Consider Exodus 28:1-2 and 29:1, 8-9. What kinds of things do we learn about priests and the care required for them to properly carry out their duties?
 - ➤ Joshua is clothed in filth. He is a sinful man. We too are sinful men and women (see Romans 3:23). How can sinful man enter the presence of a Holy God and be found acceptable?

The Need for Intercession: The High Priest

- 5. The vision of the high priest in Zechariah emphasizes the need for the intercession of God's people. Can man be made right with God on his own? How does the Christian faith emphasize the idea of intercession to bring about salvation/redemption? Read Hebrews 7:23-27. Discuss.
 - ➤ The high priests who served throughout the Old Testament were sinful and needed to be cleansed in order to serve as intercessors for God's people. What does God do for Joshua in v.4-5 in order to cleanse him and enable him to minister on behalf of God's people?

The Righteousness of God: Robed in Holiness

6. How does the picture of Joshua point us to the ministry of our great high priest, the Lord Jesus? How does Christ intercede for us? Read Hebrews 10:11-14. Read also 2 Corinthians 5:21.
