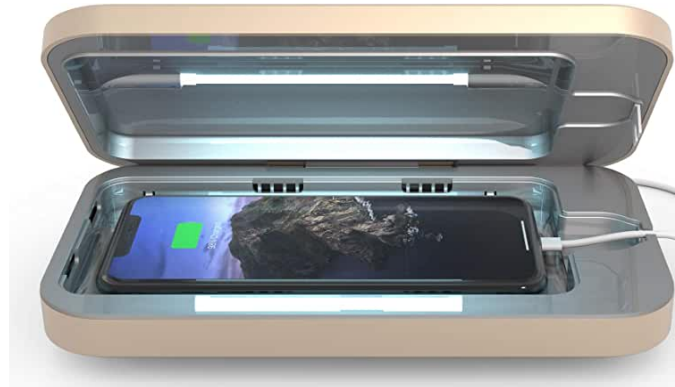

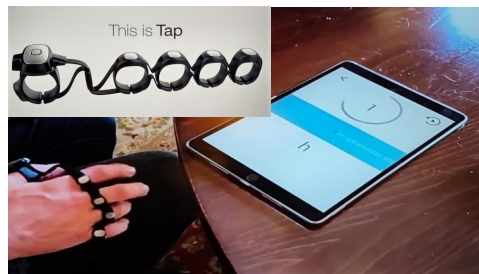

O.J. Simpson went from America's football hero, to actor, to sports announcer, to accused murderer. After he was found innocent in the trial of the century he led a quiet life. That's until he went to Las Vegas and strong armed a person to return his coveted sports memorabilia. Simpson claimed his sports memento's were stolen. The Nevada authorities saw different and charged him with kidnapping and armed robbery. O.J. served 9 years of a 33 year sentence. He was released in 2017. Simpson was scheduled to be released from his parole obligation on February 9, 2022. The department responsible for parole in Nevada released a statement that verified Simpson's early discharge on December 6, 2021.

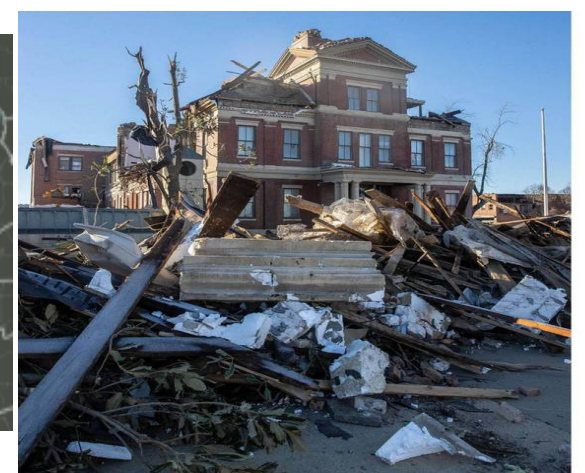

CORONAVIRUS COVID-19

OMICRON IS HERE AND DELTA IS RAGING

By now we hoped the Coronavirus would be gone. It's not. In fact, it seems as though it's gearing up for another onslaught to wreak havoc upon humanity. Here's the latest: The Centers For Disease Control (CDC) say the new Omicron variant of COVID-19 might not be as deadly as it was originally feared to be. **PLEASE REMEMBER: That's what they are saying now. We should be very, very careful.** The Omicron variant is new. Therefore, there is not enough data available to predict the long term effects on society. Here's what we do know: The Omicron variant is spreading quickly and is highly transmissible. To successfully fight off the Omicron variant the CDC recommends being fully vaccinated and getting a booster shot.. The rapid spread of Omicron is evidenced by the numbers in the country where the new variant was initially detected, South Africa. According to Johns Hopkins University, in the two week period prior to November 29th there were 8.07 new cases per 100,000 people. Just two weeks later, on December 13th, the infection rate rose to 34.37 new Omicron cases. It's important to note, although the infection rate increased the death rate didn't during the same period. On the other hand, IN MICHIGAN, the death rate for those infected with the Delta variant has increased drastically. In the summer of 2021 we thought the Coronavirus was coming to an end because only thirty-four people died in the 7 day period from July 16th through July 23rd. However, according to the CDC, the recent death toll has increased greatly. A whopping 1,245 people died from December 2nd through December 9th. An increase of 3562%! The numbers don't lie. The COVID-19 pandemic is far from over.

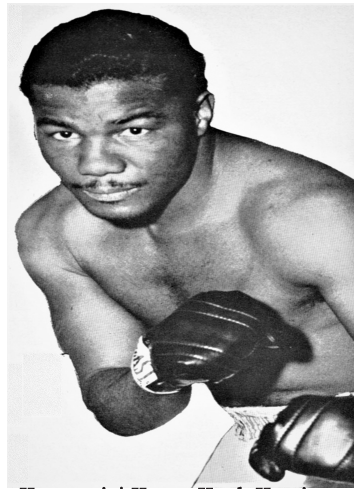

City's handling of the new State Fair Transit Center a mixed blessing

News reports of the outcome of the November 23, 2021 City Council meeting were all positive. The city administration and council agreed to revise the original purchase agreement regarding the sale of the city's portion of the fairgrounds to developers linked to behemoth Amazon. The amended agreement stipulated the rescue of the Dairy Cattle Building and its repurposing for a future State Fair Transit Center.

Mayor Duggan and his administration would never have re-purposed the Dairy Cattle Building as the future State Fair Transit Center if it weren't for the public's pressure. The same goes for the Bandshell which was dismantled and stored for an eventual move to Palmer Park. These were people's victories, to be sure. The historic Coliseum, however, is still slated for demolition.

Duggan stated on the day the city purchased 142 acres of the fairgrounds in March 2018 that he would likely demolish the historic structures. He placed no value on the shared culture and importance of our history, nor on the economic opportunity envisioned through reuse of the historic structures for transit-oriented development.

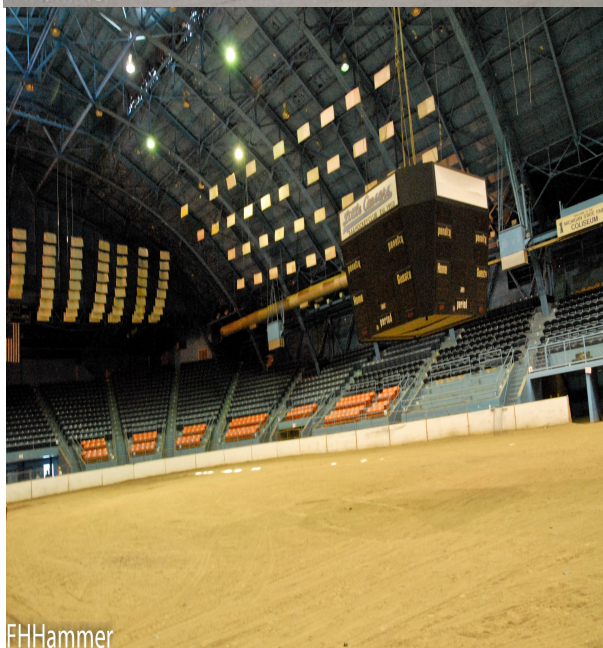
In the lead up to the November 23, 2021 City Council meeting, where the vote was taken on the fate of the buildings, Duggan spokesmen broadcasted an ultimatum through multiple media outlets: City Council must acquiesce to the demolition of the Coliseum to save the Dairy Cattle Building, or lose both. Five council members did just that with two voting "no." President Pro-tem Mary Sheffield and Councilmember Raquel Castaneda-Lopez.

Detroit's 2022 City Council will feature six new Council members, including Council woman Angela W Calloway representing District 2 where the fairgrounds are located. During "public comment" on Nov. 23rd, she expressed support for repurposing the Coliseum.

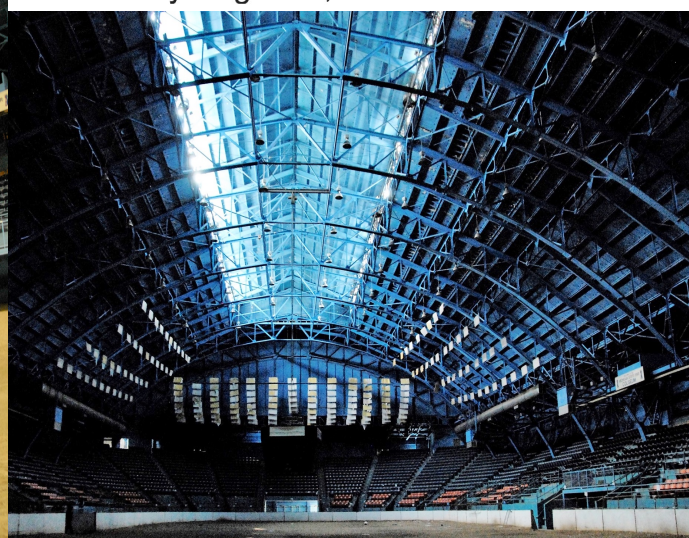
The unbridled threat has been and is an omen for Duggan's operating agenda, but the community's agenda, voice and interests will not be silenced and will continue.

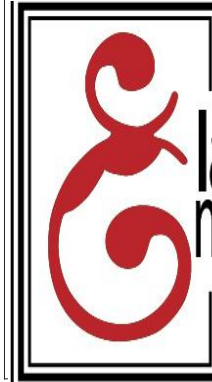

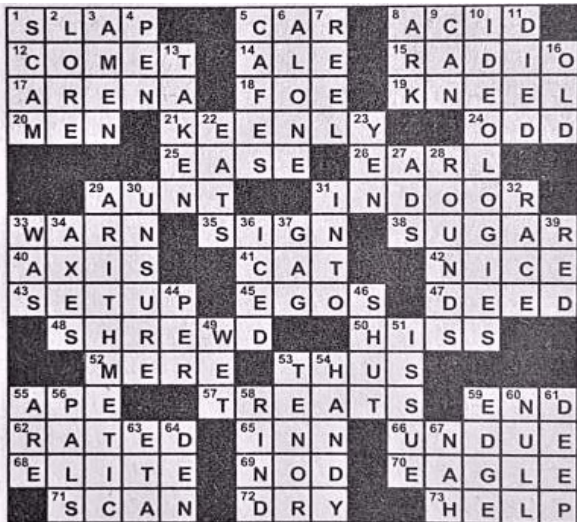

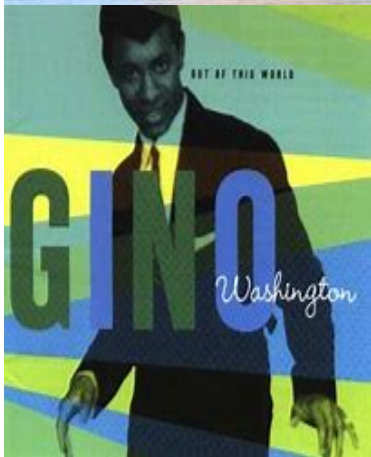
