

#### **BEFORE and AFTER**

You are looking at the northwest corner of Fort and Griswold streets in Downtown Detroit. The building on the left is the historic, and long forgotten, Hammond Building. Construction began on March 14, 1889 and was completed later that year. The quick construction is even more impressive when the work stoppages are factored in. Why were there work stoppages? Labor shortage? NO. Labor strikes? NO. Bad weather? NO. The Hammond Building had several work stoppages due to the lack of quality mules. When the work was done. The Hammond Building rose to 151 feet in height. At the time its 10 stories made it the tallest building in Michigan. In 1956 the Hammond building was demolished to make way for the National Bank of Detroit (NBD) Building. NBD was completed in 1959 and it's still a major part of Downtown Detroit. The building stands 204 feet and has 14 floors. The structure has had several owners (and names) through the years. After it was called the NBD Building it was called Bank One Center, the next name was the Chase Tower, Quicken Loans bought the building in April 2011 and renamed it The Qube. That's what the building is known as today. Here at The Monthly Standard we like the building but it would be nice to build an additional 30 floors on top of it.


## **SPORTS WITH TREY** LIONS

#### Be a Good Neighbor, Shovel Your Snow & Salt Your Walkways

Sadly, in Michigan you don't have to be a good neighbor. In slip and fall cases concerning Black Ice the victim almost always loses in a court of law. Under Michigan Law landowners are duty bound to protect pedestrians on their property from an unreasonable risk of injury caused by dangerous conditions. Unfortunately, there is an exception to this rule. It's called the open and obvious doctrine. In other words, if it rained early in the day, and the temperature fell below freezing later on that day. You should know, it's obvious, ice would form. Therefore, it's your duty to keep yourself safe by being on the lookout. In Michigan even invisible Black Ice is protected by the Courts. In the Slaughter vs. Blarney Castle Oil Company case, the Michigan Court of Appeals stated: Black Ice can be construed as open and obvious if there is "evidence that the black ice in question would have been visible on casual inspection before the fall." Or, another "indicia of a potentially hazardous condition." In Michigan, we must BE ALERT while walking and driving in suspected icy conditions. Many of us are home and business owners. If we are good neighbors our brethren will be safe and injury free. Look out for the other guy. Maintain your property. Shovel snow. Then salt.




## **SPORTS WITH TREY** MICHIGAN FOOTBALL



A year ago the Michigan Wolverines finally got over the hump. They beat Ohio State and won the Big Ten Championship for the first time since 2003. They also made the college football playoffs for the first time. This season they showed it was not a fluke because they did it again. This year's team was even more impressive when you consider the Wolverines lost their three best starters on defense in Adrian Hutchinson, David Ojabo, and Dax Hill to the NFL. Many thought Michigan would suffer a drop in play and leadership based on those losses. Another bone of contention was the controversial quarterback competition Coach Jim Harbaugh created early in the season. In the end, last year's starter Cade McNamara was benched in favor of the talented five-star QB J.J. McCarthy. (The disheartened McNamara has since transferred to the lowa Hawkeyes). Harbaugh has always been about letting the best player play, and that's what happened. The Wolverines are 13-0 this year with a statistically better defense and more potent offense than last year's team. This year Michigan went into Columbus and left with a win versus the Buckeyes for the first time since the year 2000. With Michigan's star running back Blake Corum only able to go for 2 plays with a knee injury, all eyes were on McCarthy. He answered the call and had his best game of the year. McCarthy passed for 3 touchdowns and 263 yards. Looking ahead, The Wolverines play TCU in this year's College Football Playoff semi-final. TCU has lost one game all season, and their QB Max Duggan finished 2nd in the Heisman voting this year. This won't be an easy game for the Wolverines to win, but with TCU being a slightly smaller team on defense, Michigan should have the advantage. Michigan plays a physical brand of smash mouth football that not many teams can matchup with and TCU hasn't seen anything like Michigan in the Big 12 conference. If Michigan wins this game, they would officially be four quarters away from winning the National Championship. Whomever they play, Ohio State or Georgia, (who play in the other semi-final) Michigan would have a bone to pick. Ohio State is self explanatory. If matched up for all the marbles, it would undoubtedly be one of the most anticipated games in the history of college football. On the other hand, Michigan got thoroughly beat down by Georgia last year. The Wolverines would love get their revenge by beating the defending national champions in a rematch. When looking at last year's team, even though they made the playoffs, there wasn't a sense that winning the whole thing was the goal. They seemed happy just to be there. Not this year's team. Last year, beating Ohio State was their Super Bowl. In 2022, the Wolverines expected to beat Ohio State and they expected to win the Big Ten championship. They accomplished both feats. Winning the National Championship is merely another obstacle in their way they ascend to the top of the mountain. It's possible we are seeing the first chapters of a legendary story at Michigan unfolding. The stars on this squad may stand the test of time to become immortal in Michigan lore, J.J. McCarthy, Blake Corum, Donovan Edwards, Ronnie Bell, Mike Sainristil, and Mike Morris. We will see. If they win two more games the National Championship will be theirs and the name of Harbaugh will be immortal too. The great Bo Schembechler had this motto emblazened on the wall at Michigan Stadium: Those Who Stay Will Be Champions." That rings true for Michigan football once again. They are back to being what we expect and what they expect from themselves. THE LEADERS AND BEST!
