

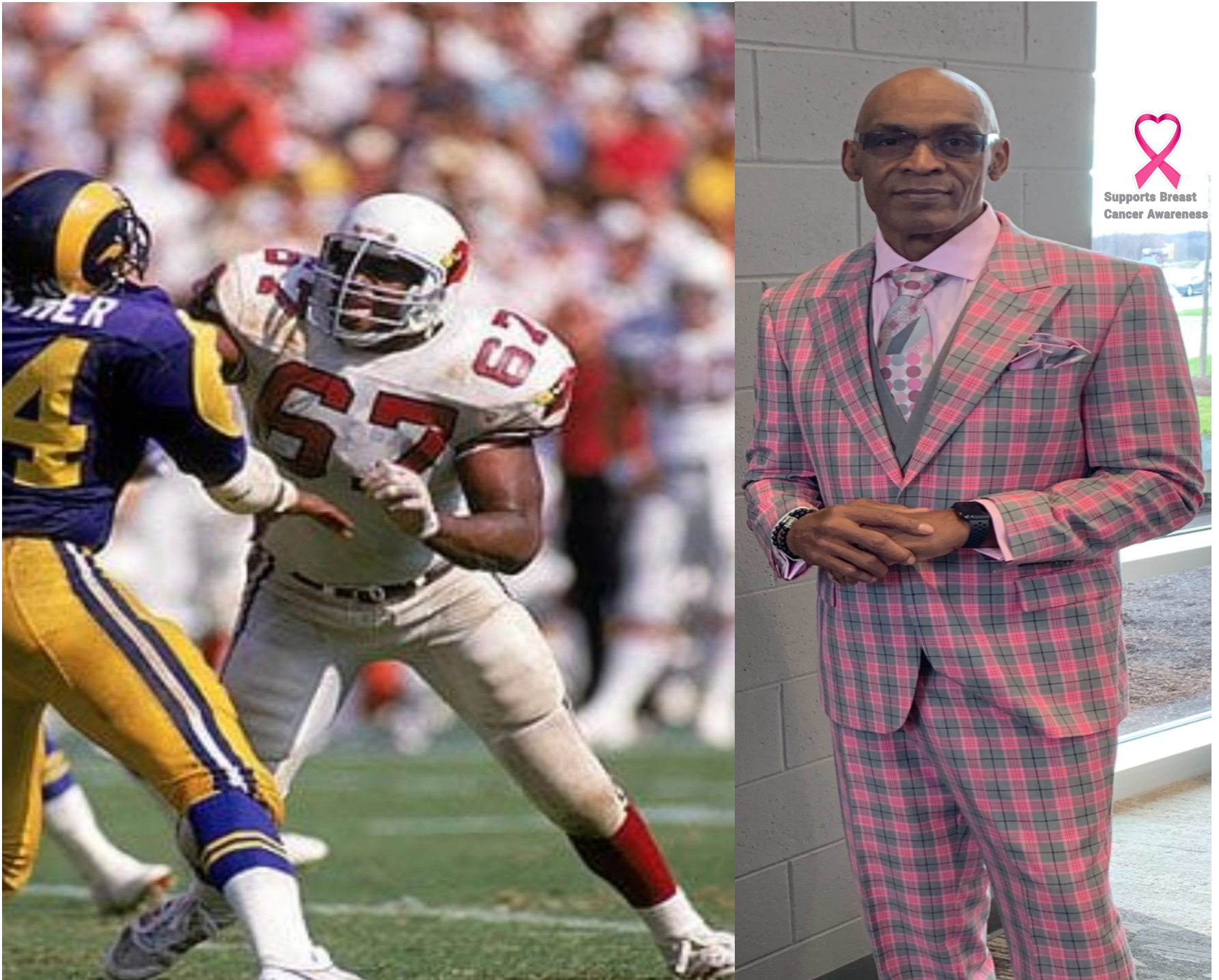

Fasting is the Best Way to Lose Weight in the New Year

Many may ask: What is fasting? **Fasting means giving up something to concentrate on God.** What we are focusing on in this article is food. SAFETY

Be a Good Neighbor, Shovel Your Snow & Salt Your Walkways

Sadly, in Michigan you don't have to be a good neighbor. In slip and fall cases concerning Black Ice the victim almost always loses in a court of law. Under Michigan Law landowners are duty bound to protect pedestrians on their property from an unreasonable risk of injury caused by dangerous conditions. Unfortunately, there is an exception to this rule. It's called the open and obvious doctrine. In other words, if it rained early in the day, and the temperature fell below freezing later on that day. You should know, it's obvious, ice would form. Therefore, it's your duty to keep yourself safe by being on the lookout. In Michigan even invisible Black Ice is protected by the Courts. In the Slaughter vs. Blarney Castle Oil Company case, the Michigan Court of Appeals stated: Black Ice can be construed as open and obvious if there is "evidence that the black ice in question would have been visible on casual inspection before the fall." Or, another "indicia of a potentially hazardous condition." In Michigan, we must **BE ALERT** while walking and driving in suspected icy conditions. Many of us are home and business owners. If we are good neighbors our brethren will be safe and injury free. Look out for the other guy. Maintain your property. Shovel snow. Then salt.

What you are viewing is the north side of Jefferson Avenue looking west from Woodward. In 1891 the corner housed the Grand Trunk Railroad ticket office. Today the site is occupied by the Minoru Yamasaki designed skyscraper at 1 Woodward Avenue. Jefferson Avenue looked busy in 1891, Why shouldn't it? Detroit was a boomtown with a approximate population of 205,000. In 1880, Detroit's population was 118,000. A 74% growth spurt in 10 years is astounding, and we did it! I believe we can do it again. From 2020 to 2030 a 74% growth spurt is achievable. Here's why: We have the people. There's over 4.2 million people in metropolitan Detroit. The 74% goal could be achieved if a little less than 12% of the metropolitan population relocate to the city. Detroit's population could rise from 673,000 today to 1,171,020. Luis Sharpe: "I Want to Change Lives Using the NFL Platform"

First impressions mean a lot. Upon meeting Luis Sharpe one gets the impression that he is a college professor. He is intelligent, articulate and affable. A person would never know the personal horror Luis Sharpe endured, unless he told you. He told us. Of course The Monthly Standard knew who Luis Sharpe was before we interviewed him. Sharpe was a former NFL star. He has always been a high achiever. He was an All American at Detroit's Southwestern High School in 1978. He was recruited by over 200 Division 1 schools. He choose UCLA in Los Angeles, In his senior season at UCLA he was All Pac 10 and was an All American at UCLA too. He was selected 16th overall in the 1st Round of the NFL draft in 1982 by the St. Louis Cardinals. In 1988, the Cardinals moved to Arizona. During his 13 seasons with the franchise Sharpe was a perpetual starter. For three straight years ('87-'89) Sharpe was selected to the Pro Bowl. (Which is the NFL All-Star game). Luis is a leader too. In 9 of his 13 years with the Cardinals his teammates voted him team Captain. On a play that ended up being offsidess Sharpe's playing career came to an end. An opposing player for the Philadelphia Eagles hit his knee from behind and tore his ACL. (Anterior Cruciate Ligament). Concerning the injury that ended his career Sharpe said: "It was tough. As is the case with most professional football players you go from being a star and making millions of dollars and having all the accolades to all of a sudden your career ends. You don't have that family connection with your teammates, and you're not making any money. After my injury, I was lost. I didn't know who I was. I didn't know what my future held. I went out in the streets, in south Phoenix (Arizona) doing things that I knew better to do and hanging out with people I shouldn't be hanging out with. As a result of that, I probably spent 10 years addicted to crack cocaine." A transpicuous Sharpe continued: "I've been shot twice. I've been to prison 3 times. I got beat down in a prison riot. After each shooting incident the doctor said it's a miracle I'm alive." Luis was shot in the shoulder the first time he got shot. The second time, he was shot under the chin, breaking his jaw. These brushes with death still did not curb Sharpe's craving for crack cocaine. He was busted for possession and received a five year sentence, which according to Luis: "felt like a lifetime to me." Not long after his incarceration started he read a headline about himself in the Arizona Republic newspaper. It read: FOOTBALL HERO TO CRACKHEAD ZERO.

EMBRACING GOD'S WORD:

Luis responded: "That headline re-energized my competitive spirit. The Devil is liar. I remember going to a Bible study and the director asked me to get up and get on my knee's and profess Jesus Christ as my Lord and Savior. And I did that. It came from the heart. The rest of the time I was incarcerated, this book that made absolutely no sense to me all of my life, all of a sudden, I started to understand the scriptures. I started to see myself in biblical characters. I started to have hope...If God could turn around an Apostle Paul he certainly could forgive me, clean me up, and use me. My life was changed while I was in prison." Because of that fact Luis Sharpe's reason for living has drastically changed. Today, he feels obliged to give. Sharpe wants to enrich humanity. His focus is our youth. "I want to share my experience and let them know they can live productive, responsible, law abiding lives, as I am doing today." Sharpe has not played for the Cardinals in 25 years, but he is still remembered and respected in Arizona. In June 2019, Scott Allen from raisingzona.com said: "His battles with New York Giants defensive end Lawrence Taylor are stories for the ages. He has also turned his life around. He uses his Facebook page to help motivate others...He was considered one of the best left tackles of all time by many. Now it's time for the Cardinals to reward him with an induction to the Ring of Honor." (At University of Phoenix Stadium).

HALL OF FAME: (HOF)

Luis Sharpe is one of the best Offensive Linemen in NFL history. That's a fact. Therefore, he should be inducted in the Professional Football Hall of Fame in Canton, Ohio. Luis has travelled all over the world, but he chose to come back home to live. He's a Detroit. We should support his candidacy, just like his fans in St. Louis and Arizona surely will. It's widely known the best Linebacker in NFL history is Lawrence Taylor. The Monthly Standard asked Taylor if Sharpe should be inducted into the Hall of Fame? Taylor replied: "Luis was as tough an offensive lineman as any during my career. I have often said he was one of the guys that gave me a lot of trouble. Always knew I had to bring my "A" game. In my mind he's an absolute Hall of Famer." Taylor is not alone in his assessment. Kenneth "Skip" McClendon, who played most of his career with the Cincinnati Bengals was one of the fiercest and most intense Defensive Ends in the NFL during the 80's and 90's. He was absolutely the best against the run. Nobody ran his way. His Hall of Fame worthy career was cut short by injuries. Here's what Skip had to say about Sharpe: "I was introduced to NFL playing the Cardinals. He taught me a lot. I remember we were battling and he was pissing me off. He kept laughing saying; "Stay low rook. You're getting too high." He was deceptively strong. Luis was a great technician. He had a motor that wouldn't quit. He reminds me of my teammate, Hall of Famer, Anthony Munoz. I would be surprised if he is not inducted in the Hall. I think he's due." We agree Skip. Luis Sharpe should be fitted for a beige HOF Blazer. He's earned it.

JIMMY HOFFA

New Film "The Irishman" is Untrue According to Former Detroit Reporter

THE MONTHLY STANDARD TOOK A CLOSER LOOK: WE BELIEVE THE IRISHMAN

It could be argued that Martin Scorsese is more than a filmmaker. He's a historian. We know Scorsese's historical movies are not 100% correct. It's common knowledge that some characters or situations are added or omitted to help the story flow smoothly. Even still, nobody has doubted the overall accuracy of his true to life movies such as: Gooffellas, Casino, and The Wolf of Wall Street. The Irishman is much different. When Scorsese made Goodfellas he consulted with the actual Henry Hill. When he made Casino, Scorsese consulted the actual Sam "Ace" Rothstein. The same is true with The Wolf of Wall Street. Scorsese consulted Jordan Belfort. The main characters in Scorsese's latest biopic are dead. The victim, Jimmy Hoffa, his killer, Frank "The Irishman" Sheeran, and the mafia chieftain Russell Bufalino. Since these men are not alive to confirm or deny their portrayal in The Irishman how do we know it's true? Scorsese based his latest film on the book "I Heard You Paint Houses" by Charles Brandt. The book is basically a dying declaration by Frank "The Irishman" Sheeran. Scorsese believes the Sheeran story. Otherwise, he wouldn't have based his film on Brandt's book. CBS News recently asked Robert Deniro (who plays Frank Sheeran) and Al Pacino (who plays Jimmy Hoffa) if they believe the story. DeNiro replied: "I do. Yep." Pacino said "Yeah, I sorta do too. Too many things, when he tells the story are so accurate...There's so many details that come out, that you just say, that's real." Scorsese, listening to Pacino's response exclaims: "Yeah, yeah." Vince Wade who formerly reported for Channel 7 and Channel 2 in Detroit disagrees. Wade, who broke the Hoffa story says: "Sheeran did not kill Jimmy Hoffa. I am not alone in thinking this." That's true. There are many naysayers. After analyzing the over 40 years worth of evidence pertaining to the Jimmy Hoffa case, The Monthly Standard does not agree with the naysayers. Here's why: The naysayers do not have an alternative theory. On the other hand, the Sheeran story makes perfectly good sense. Every Sheeran claim fits what we know about organized crime. Hoffa was street smart, and his cautious nature was well known. He would never get into a car, unless, there was somebody he trusted implicitly in the vehicle. When Hoffa saw Sheeran he felt secure and coolly got into the car.

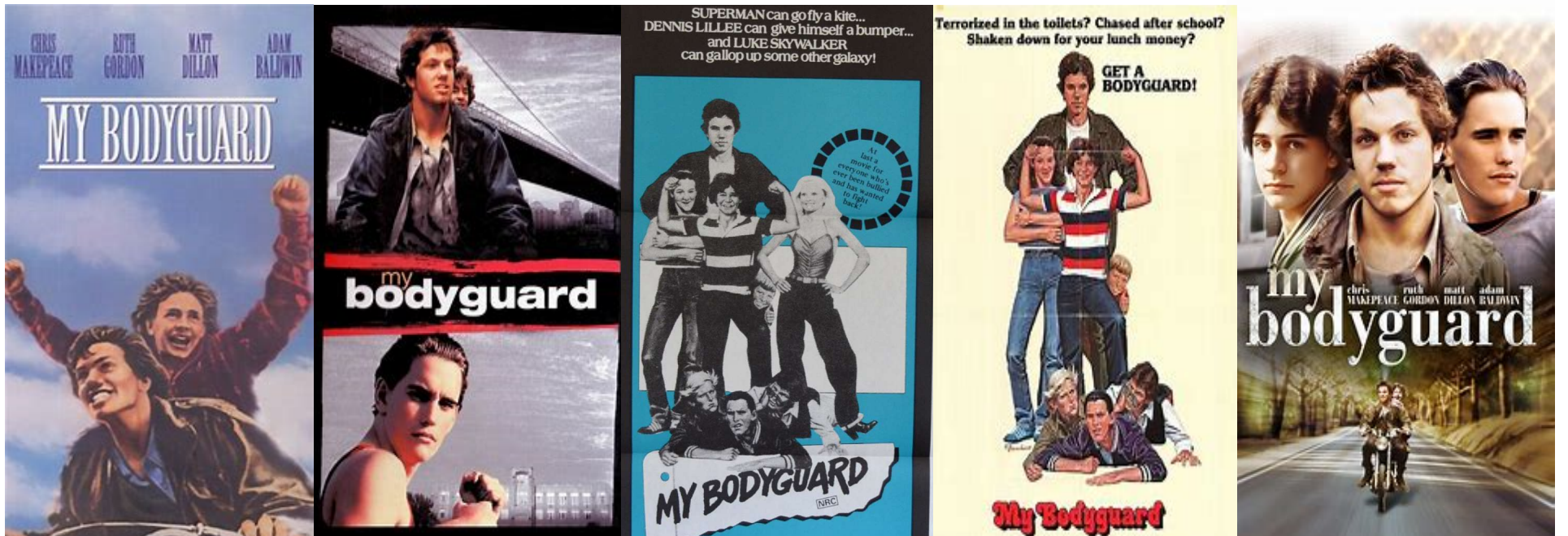

The mob knew only his good friend Sheeran could get close enough to kill Hoffa. That's why they gave him the contract. Sheeran had to do it. Otherwise he would be killed. Hoffa's execution was a well planned operation. All the dots connect. Hoffa was driven from the Machus Red Fox to 17841 Beaverland Street in Detroit. After Sheeran killed Hoffa he promptly left the city. His job was done. The clean up team was responsible for transporting Hoffa to his final destination. Sheeran knew what was going to happen next. He just wasn't there. That's why he incorrectly assumed Hoffa was incinerated at a funeral home. **THE MONTHLY STANDARD HAS EXCLUSIVE INFORMATION REGARDING THE FINAL STOP OF JAMES RIDDLE HOFFA.** He was cremated at Grand Lawn Cemetery located at Grand River and Telegraph. Grand Lawn is 3 minutes from Beaverland. Vince Wade was an Investigative Reporter in name only. It seems he never investigated anything pertaining to the Hoffa case. He only conducted interviews. Primarily with FBI Agent Bob Garrity. Here's the problem. The FBI joined the Hoffa investigation 4 days late. When I told Wade that a dying Sheeran had no reason to lie he said: "Frank Sheeran was a lying, washed up, thug alcoholic. And those were his good points." In reality Sheeran was a mafia soldier who kept his mouth shut. The "wiseguys" knew Hoffa was already dust in the wind the night of July 30, 1975. The job of the mob is elude capture. In the Hoffa case they succeeded. Not one person has been prosecuted in the murder of Jimmy Hoffa.

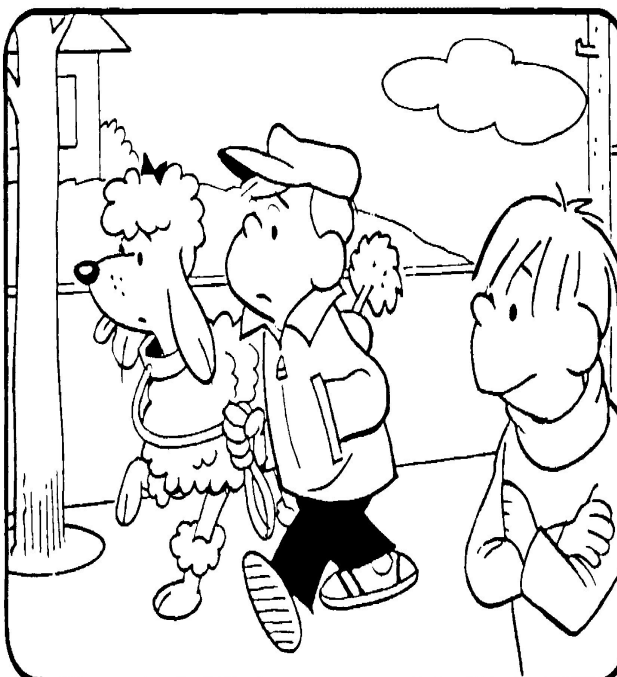
