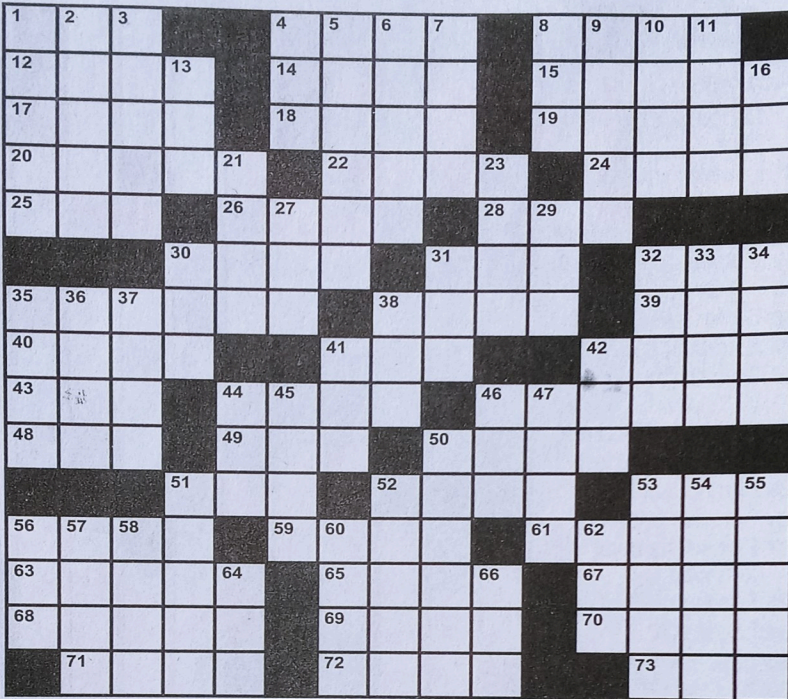

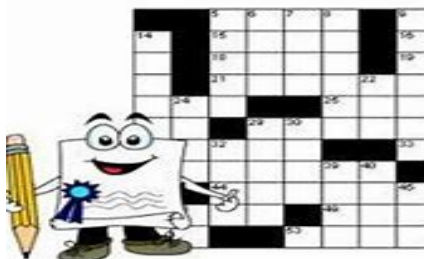

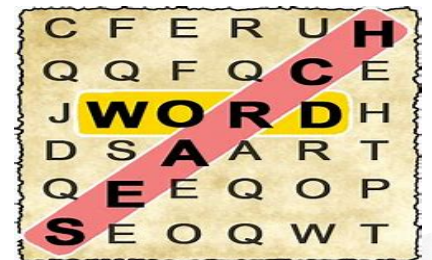

### Carl's Chop House



This entire edition of "Places We Miss In Detroit" is brought to by Eric Adams of Detroit, Michigan. Mr. Adams is a loyal reader of The Monthly Standard, and we truly appreciate his patronage. For years, Carl's Chop House was a Detroit institution. The big Steer atop the CARL'S sign at Grand River and Hobson was classic Detroit. Carl's closed in 2008, and was demolished in 2010. At right is the Hotel Statler. Mr. Eric Adams adds: "The Hotel Statler was in Grand Circus Park off of Park St. between Bagley and Washington Blvd. I believe my mom used to work there when she came up from the South in the late 1960's as an elevator operator. That's after the Hilton chain bought it, calling it the Statler-Hilton Hotel." WOW! Great job Eric! Thank you for your submission. TMS invites ALL OF YOU to submit your ideas. The Hotel Statler closed in 1975. It stood vacant to 40 years before being demolished in 2005.

Pictured above is the corner of Randolph and East Congress looking to the west down Congress. The corner to the west is Woodward Avenue. The street to the south is Larned. The picture from 1964 is the old Greyhound Bus Terminal. It was a cavernous structure. The station had a large seating area and hundreds of lockers. There was a Cafeteria inside, and later, a Burger King too. The Larned side housed a Motel. The building also had public parking on the roof. The Greyhound Terminal was razed in 1990 to make way for the One Detroit Center skyscraper and parking garage. One Detroit Center, now called Ally Detroit Center, is the second tallest building in Detroit behind the Ren Cen's Marriot Hotel. The Ally Detroit Center is definitely an upgrade in that space. Many derelicts frequented the bus terminal. So much so, the surrounding area began to smell of urine. We prefer the skyscraper.
