





# Wayne County Treasurer Eric Sabree Reminds Homeowners Help Is Available

## The Wayne County Treasurer's Office Urges Homeowners to Act Now

If you're a Wayne County homeowner or property owner struggling to keep up with delinquent property taxes, help is available, but you must act soon. The Wayne County Treasurer's Office is reminding residents that March 31, 2026, is the deadline to enroll in a taxpayer assistance payment plan, and you can get started right now at home using convenient online resources at [WayneCountyMI.gov/Treasurer](https://WayneCountyMI.gov/Treasurer)

"We don't want anyone to lose their home or property to foreclosure, and we have taxpayer assistance programs to help you," said Wayne County Treasurer Eric R. Sabree. "The deadline to enroll in these programs is March 31, 2026, so we encourage you to go online or contact us to get started today. Our team is standing by to help you."

### Three Programs are available to Help You Stay in Your Home:

#### 1. Stipulated Payment Agreement (REGSPA)

For taxpayers who qualify, REGSPA provides a structured agreement to repay delinquent property taxes over time, helping households move toward compliance through clearly defined payment terms. If you owe back taxes and need a manageable plan to pay them, this may be the right option for you.

#### 2. Distressed Owner/Occupant Extension (DOOE)

If you are an owner-occupant facing financial hardship, DOOE is designed to give you additional time to resolve delinquent taxes while you work to remain in your home. This program recognizes the real challenges that families face and provides flexibility for those who need it most.

#### 3. Interest Reduction Stipulated Payment Agreement (IRSPA)

IRSPA offers eligible taxpayers a payment plan that may include reduced interest charges, easing the overall cost of repaying delinquent taxes. For those who qualify, this program can make a difference in what you ultimately owe.

# SWEET LOU WHITAKER

## The Contemporary Baseball Era Committee Votes Again in Late 2028, The Time to Start Promoting Lou is NOW!

It's a travesty that "Sweet Lou" Whitaker is not in the Baseball Hall of Fame. This Detroit Tigers fan favorite is one of the all-time greats in baseball history. This article isn't about sentimentality. It's about FACTS! Sweet Lou was a vacuum cleaner in the field. Whitaker won 3 Gold Glove Awards for being the best fielding second baseman in the American League. At the plate Lou was ALWAYS reliable. He was known as the best leadoff man in baseball. Whitaker won 4 Silver Slugger Awards for being the best hitter at his position. Lou Whitaker's statistics are on par with Alan Trammell's. For some reason Trammell (who is deserving) is in the Hall of Fame but Lou Whitaker isn't. Does that make sense to you? Trammell & Whitaker were rookies in 1978, and became the best double play combo of the 1980's, and consequently in baseball history. When they played, many looked upon Lou as the best one of the pair. Whitaker won the 1978 Rookie of the Year Award. Remarkably, their career stats are very similar.

The stats don't lie. Out of the eight statistics listed above Whitaker beat Trammell in six of them. What's truly amazing is Whitaker achieved his numbers in 19 seasons compared to 20 seasons played by Trammell. That means Trammell had an extra year to catch Whitaker in vital categories such as Hits, RBI, and Home Runs but he still didn't catch up to Lou. The head to head comparison stats of Whitaker and Trammell should be more than enough evidence for the committee that's responsible for electing new members. That body is the 16 member Contemporary Baseball Era Committee. The committee is comprised of Hall of Fame players, executives, and media. Alan Trammell was on the 2025 committee and Lou still didn't get elected. Lou's next chance for induction is is the HOF ceremony in 2029. Here at The Monthly Standard we feel the time to start campaigning for Whitaker is NOW. There are 20 second basemen in the Hall of Fame. Lou's stats are as good or better than many Hall of Fame second basemen. Lou's .276 batting average is better than 5 HOF'ers, including Joe Morgan. Lou has more hits than 9 second basemen in the Hall. one of which is Ryne Sandberg. Lou has more Home Runs than 15 of the second basemen in the Hall. One of them happens to be Roberto Alomar. Sweet Lou has more runs batted in than noted New York Yankee Hall of Fame Murders Row second baseman Tony Lazzeri. Whitaker's bWAR stat of 75.1% is outstanding. The bWAR stat measures past performance to evaluate a player's actual contribution to team wins. **Lou Whitaker's bWAR must not be underrated:** Whitaker's 75.1 bWAR is significantly higher than that of Hall of Famers Ryne Sandberg, Roberto Alomar, and Craig Biggio. He ranks 7th all-time at the position; the six players ahead of him are all Hall of Famers. **Power Hitting:** Whitaker is one of only five second basemen in history to record over 2,000 hits, 200 home runs, 1,000 RBIs, and 1,000 walks. The others are: Rogers Hornsby, Joe Morgan, Roberto Alomar, and Craig Biggio, and ALL of them are in the Hall of Fame. It's not too early to start propping up Sweet Lou. The 2028 vote will be here before you know it.

## In the 1930's Detroit was the Cat's Meow!

**TIGERS-LIONS-RED WINGS AND THE GREAT JOE LOUIS WERE AT THE TOP OF THEIR GAME**

For those who do not know, the cat's meow is good, and was a term widely used in the 1930's. Today people say, you are cool!

### CHAMPIONS DAY

Back in 1936 there were so many champions in Detroit a city councilman named Eugene Van Anterp proposed a special Champions Day for our sports heroes. The proposal was quickly endorsed and made an official proclamation by Michigan Governor Frank Fitzgerald. The event was held on April 19, 1936 to commemorate a number of sporting victories and accomplishments by Detroit, Michigan natives and teams in the early 1930s, and especially the 1935-36 sports season.


That special season was called "...the most amazing sweep of sport achievements ever credited to any single city" by the Windsor Daily Star. That sports season featured, among other things the rise of Joe Louis in the professional boxing world, the Detroit Tigers winning their first World Series, the Detroit Lions winning their first NFL championship, and the Detroit Red Wings winning their first Stanley Cup championship.

The Detroit Times (once a daily newspaper in Detroit that ceased operations in 1960) planned a "testimonial" dinner in support of Governor Fitzgerald's proclamation. Before the proclamation was announced plans were already being made for the upcoming event. They began selling tickets as early as April 6. A ticket for the dinner cost \$3. (Which is about \$75.00 in today's money). Ads for the dinner indicated that "The banquet will honor all of Detroit's champions, including the 1935 World Series champion Detroit Tigers, 1935 NFL champion Detroit Lions, 1935-36 Stanley Cup champion Detroit Red Wings. (They won it again in 1936-37). In 1937 pugilist Joe Louis won the heavyweight boxing championship.

The party was held at the Detroit Masonic Temple. Over 600 fans attended the paid event. Manila "Bud" Shaver, sports editor of the Detroit Times, emceed the event. The celebration was broadcast on the radio station WXYZ-AM in Detroit. Many of the athletes from the team sports gave speeches at the event, however Joe Louis did not speak. Governor Fitzgerald also spoke at the banquet. **Can history repeat itself?**



The 1936-37 Detroit Red Wings celebrate their second consecutive Stanley Cup Championship


