Semiconductor Shortage Stops Production at Auto Plants

Could this Be the Beginning of a New World Order?

Automakers have a major problem to solve. Silicon chips. More commonly known as semiconductors are used in various systems throughout the vehicle. Cars are getting smarter. That's why automakers are using more and more silicon chips. Semiconductors are used in rear view cameras, the entertainment system, brake sensors, the power steering apparatus, and more! Every automaker uses many silicon chips per automobile. We are not just talking about the Big 3 in Detroit. Automakers worldwide rely on Chinese made semiconductors. That's why there is a shortage. The demand for silicon chips is too great for workers in China to keep up.



It was falsely reported that General Motors closed three plants across the country for weather related reasons. It's now known that GM closed their factories because of a shortage of semiconductors. The closed GM Assembly plants are: Bowling Green, Kentucky, Fort Wayne, Indiana, Arlington, Texas and Spring Hill, Tennessee. The Ford Motor Company closed their Chicago Assembly Plant due to a "parts shortage." Additionally, Ford has shut down a factory in Germany. Also, in Germany, Volkswagen said they are slowing down production due to the chip shortage. Honda Motors has closed their plant in the town of Swindon in Wiltshire, England. The semiconductor shortage has affected local auto plants too. Two metropolitan Detroit Fiat Chrysler plants, Jefferson North, and Warren Truck are closed. Ronda Simmons-Douglas said: *"Management told us that we will be off work for at least 3 weeks. That's too long. Having a week off is ok, but three weeks is too long to be off. I have bills to pay and unemployment checks don't cut it."* Is this the beginning of a new balance of power worldwide? Based upon current events, this tiny semiconductor is what could possibly hold the key to world domination in the near future. China holds the key. Not the USA. Americans interests MUST begin to manufacture semiconductors. If not, don't be caught off guard when the Chinese begin to dominate world affairs.
