





How time flies! Tiger Stadium is LOOOOONG GONE, and the Detroit Tigers have been playing in their new ballpark for 23 years now. Before Comerica Park was constructed the Young Women's Christian Association (YWCA) stood on that ground at 2230 Witherell for almost 70 years. Ground was broken on June 20, 1928. The large 10 story building quickly opened to the public only a year later in 1929. In the 1970's and 80's they rented out their large ballroom for parties. In the 90's a homeless shelter was on the top floor. The YWCA was demolished in 1998. In 1999, the Detroit Tigers began constructing Comerica Park. It remains the home of the Tigers.



Gibbs game has shades of Alvin Kamara, but he's not as big. Gibbs is a very dynamic playmaker with a knack for catching the ball. His athletic capabilities are great. He can change direction at the drop of a hat. He is also able to stop and start while controlling his speed better than most players. The Lions could even put him in the slot on 3rd down. He's that good of a receiver. Although Gibbs lacks a great physical profile he is a gifted athlete who can be a star in the NFL



Jack Campbell

This feels like a true Dan Campbell pick. Campbell was an All-Big Ten Conference player and the Dick Butkus award winner last year. He has elite size for a linebacker standing 6'5" & 249 lbs. A stout run defender, he regularly plugged the middle for the Hawkeyes throughout his career. He should be able to come in and immediately be an impact player for the Lions. However, he has some athletic limitations that show up primarily in pass coverage. He will be beaten in certain situations. Particularly in man coverage. Solid pick.



Sam LaPorta

The Lions second pick in a row from Iowa. Laporta was an All-Big Ten conference selection for the Hawkeyes. While not the tallest player or best blocker at 6'3" & 245 lbs, he makes up for it with great speed, acceleration, and maximum effort. The Lions had a huge need at the tight end position after trading away T.J. Hockenson. The team addressed the need quickly. This is another pick that feels very on brand for Dan Campbell.

LIONS

Brad Holmes is Building a Champion Here's the Rest of the Lions Draft Picks



Branch is a safety who played slot corner in college at Alabama. An All-American, he has great instinct when reading the field and is almost playing a step ahead of everyone else. An exceptional tackler, he only missed four tackles in his entire career. Speed is a question mark. He only ran a 4.58 in the 40 yard dash at the combine. Even if he cannot convert to safety, the Lions drafted the best nickel corner in the draft in the 2nd round.



Hooker was a potential Heisman Trophy candidate until he tore his ACL. He threw for 27 touchdowns and only 2 interceptions. While his age (25) isn't ideal, athletes have more longevity than ever before and Hooker could be a starting level quarterback for a decade with proper development. A similar skillset to Dak Prescott. Hooker is absolutely worth a 3rd round pick.



Martin is a raw and athletic nose tackle. He has great size at 6'5" and 337 lbs. He uses his power and strength to win on the inside. Martin is very quick for his size and could be a solid player for Detroit down the road. He had 31 tackles and was an All-Conference USA honorable mention in 2022. There's a lot of upside to Martin. Players with his size and quickness do not grow on trees.



Colby Sorsdal

Sorsdal was a five-year starter at right tackle for William and Mary. He made 46 career starts. He was a first team All-FCS All-American as a senior. He could end up switching to guard due to the Lions depth at tackle. A knock on him would be playing at the FCS level. That's a bigger jump to the NFL than FBS players. He has great size standing 6'6" and weighing in at 301 lbs. He could be a steal for the Lions down the road.



Last season wide receiver Antoine Green had 800 yards and 9 touchdowns in only nine games. Using his 6'2" frame, he is adept at winning battles for deep balls down the field. Pair that with a 4.47 time in the 40 yard dash, and the Lions are looking at a fast deepthreat with some upside. Green is a good value pick for the Lions to end their draft.


