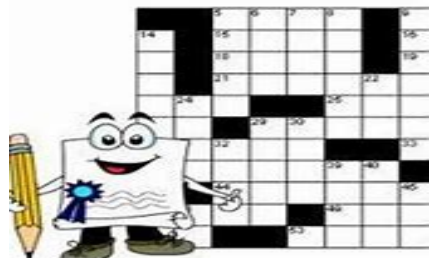

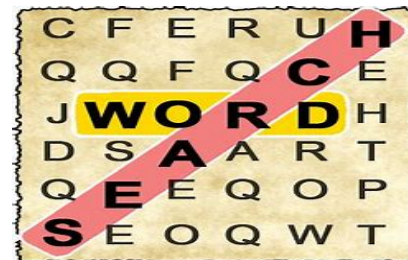

You are looking at West Congress Street in Downtown Detroit. The vehicles are traveling westbound. Both pictures are between Cass and First Streets. We can surely see major changes over 85 years. The Gothic Ally Detroit Center (on Woodward) compliments the Art Deco inspired Guardian Building. The Buhl Building and the flat topped Ford Building still sit across the street from each other at West Congress and Griswold. Next to the Buhl you can see three windows from the historic Murphy Building. Built in 1903 the structure is still in pristine condition. In the 1980's the building housed the popular tourist attraction and souvenir shop "Emily's On the Corner." At Washington Boulevard we see the Marquette Building. In 2024, the People Mover & the Cobo Center can be seen

President John F. Kennedy was Shot From the Left, not the Right



When the assassination of President John F. Kennedy on November 22, 1963 is discussed, most Americans agree that you cannot trust the official cover story the government provided. When the Warren Commission released their investigation in 1964 it was immediately criticized for leaving out vital information. The fact is, millions of Americans do not believe the Warren Commission report. This article is not going to pick apart the Warren Commission report. The United States Congress already did that when a Congressional investigation was conducted from 1976 to 1979. Congress concluded a "probable conspiracy" in the assassination of President Kennedy. Congress recommended the Justice Department investigate further. Over 40 years later the Justice Department has stood still. It's abundantly clear: There were more than three shots fired at JFK. Two of those shots hit the Kennedy limousine itself. One bullet (from behind) hit the frame above the rear view mirror. Another bullet appeared to hit the windshield from the front. This article is about The South Knoll. It's NEVER spoken about. Here at The Monthly Standard (TMS) we find that silence concerning. The fact is, that vital part of Dealey Plaza in Dallas is ignored. That's a major clue! **FORENSIC SCIENCE DOES NOT LIE**-Let's look at the facts pertaining to this case. Examine the three pictures on this page. The picture at top left shows Jackie Kennedy assisting JFK after he was shot in the back. (Which exited out of his throat). The middle picture is the most important of the set. That picture was taken one millisecond before JFK's head explodes. Pay close attention to the mist that obscures Jackie's face. That is back spatter. JFK has already been shot in the head. Blood back spatter exits opposite to the point of impact. The middle picture proves the JFK headshot came from the left. The back right of his head exploded because he was shot with a high powered rifle from the left front. The direction of the impact is also why Kennedy fell back and to the left. The bottom picture shows the aftermath of the Kennedy assassination. The pictures above are from frames 312 and 313 of the home video shot by Dallas dressmaker Abraham Zapruder. Almost sixty-one years after the fact the evidence shows the killers used the Grassy Knoll as a diversion. People heard a shot and saw a puff of smoke. When the crowd ran towards the Grassy Knoll they were met by legions of people who said they were law enforcement. TMS believes the Umbrella Man and his dark complected cohort were spotters for the shooter stationed across the way on the South Knoll. 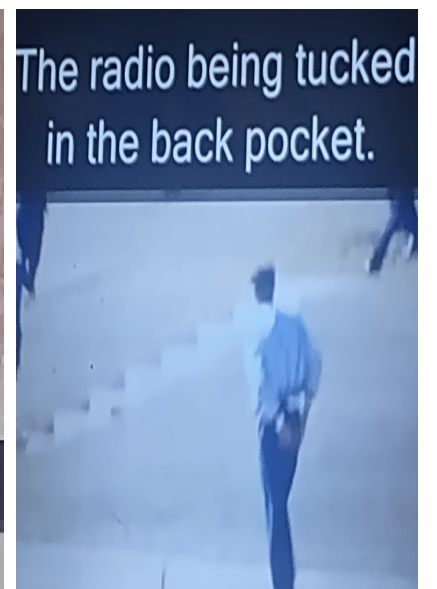
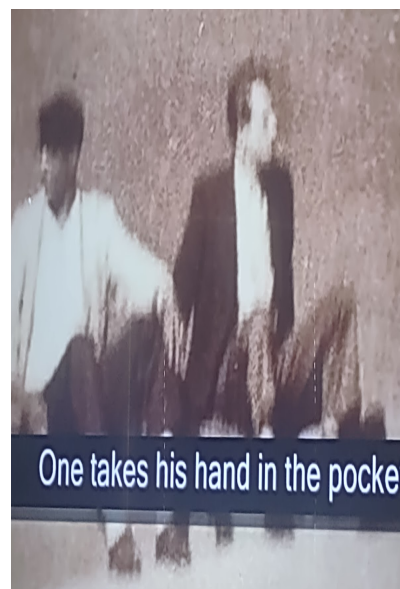

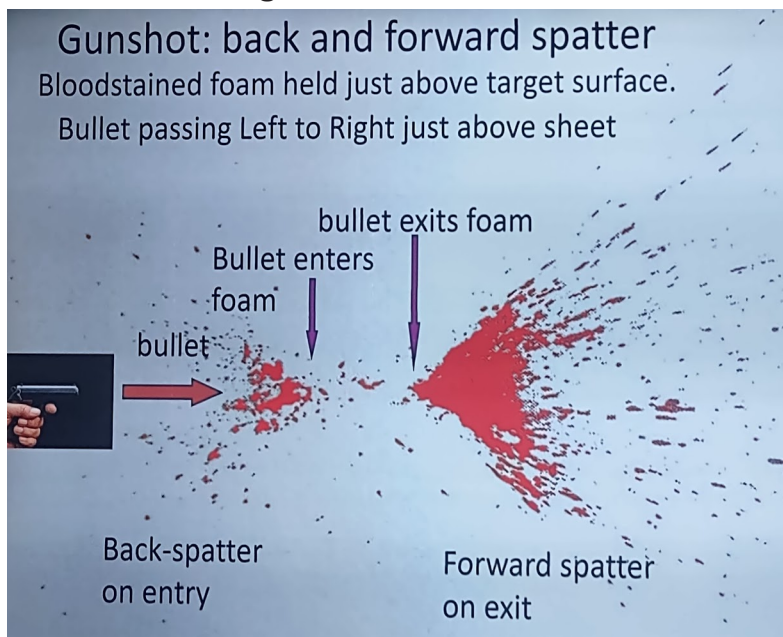
JFK-Every Picture Tells a Story

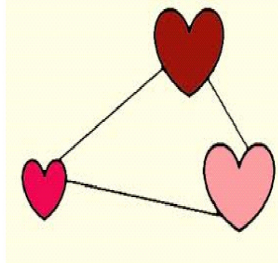

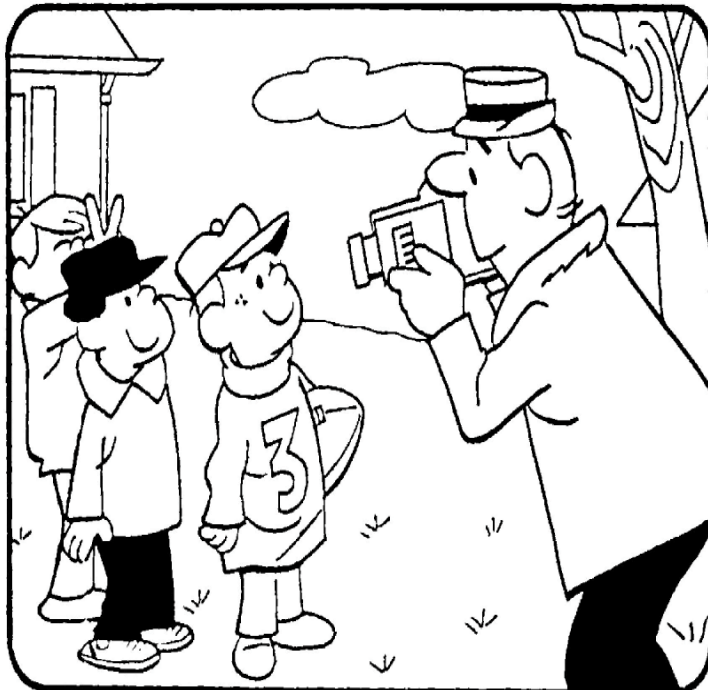
