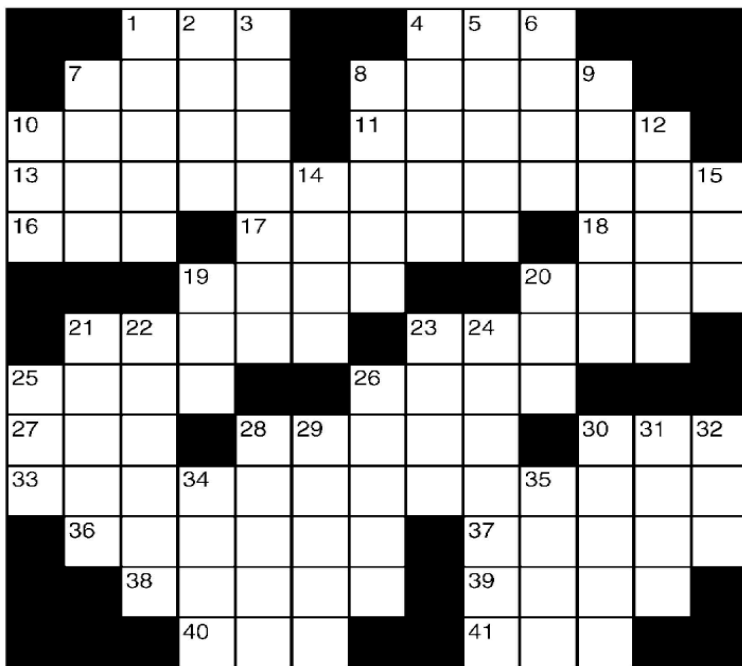

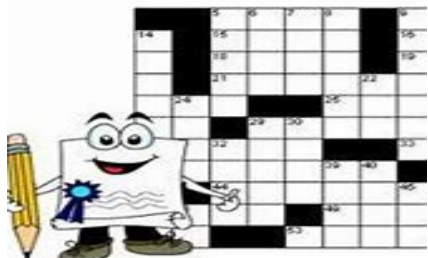

Believe it or not, the building on the N.E. corner of Woodward and Grand Blvd. is 110 years old. The picture on the left shows how the building looked in its first 55 years of existence. The face-lift that began in 1965 has held up well. The 1965 photo is remarkable because it shows the old and the new. Look to the far right and you can see the beginning stages of the new facade. The building was designed by the renowned Albert Kahn and built by the Ford Motor Company in 1910. The original name of the structure was the Ford Sales and Service Building. Ford moved out of the building in 1919 and sold it to real estate developer Stormfeltz-Loveley. The location continued to be Detroit's most popular office building. Detroit's auto show was housed there for years. The forerunner of WJLB (WMBC) broadcast from there, and the building even had an 18 hole golf course on the 8th floor. **Thanks to HistoricDetroit.org**
