Hi to all our members and the broader community.

Covid-19 has kept us on our toes for the last few months and continues to be a threat to a normalised life.

Event management continues to be frustrated by additional requirements to ensure public safety.

The Association has had to make some careful decisions concerning the End Of Summer Surf Festival 2021, particularly the major drawcard, the Golden Beach Surf Fishing Competition.

As an alternative to not proceeding with **EOSSF** event again this year, the Committee Of Management has decided to opt for a streamlined event that was manageable under any possible Covid-19 condition that may eventuate.

Whilst we financially survived a total shutdown of last years event, planning as if nothing could happen this year would have been nothing short of being reckless. We also recognise that sections of the Golden Beach Community rely on some activity to stimulate their business or group at this time of the year.

In recognition of Bill Hammer's contribution to the community, the Association has named this year's Fishing Competition:

The Bill Hammer Ninety Mile Beach Surf Fishing Competition.

It is planned that this year's competition's new form will grow to be the largest single-day (EOSSF) event on Easter Saturday.

The stripped-down version will be a secret weight and winner take all cash prize.

Easter Saturday 2021

This year we have moved the MARKET DAY into the sealed area of the RV Site. A variety of 20 stallholders have booked sites that are 6 m x 3 m and provided free. During the day between 10 am and 2 pm, musician Ryan Lestrange will provide patrons with a mixture of his songs' repertoire.

Ryan will join us again between 5 pm and 7 pm in the open garden, where we invite all to come along partake in the fundraiser BBQ provided by the GB Surf Club, bring a chair and enjoy a relaxing evening.

The Monster Easter Raffle will be drawn at 7 pm along with the announcement of the fishing Competition winner.

GOLDEN BEACH TOWN CENTRE REVITALISATION PLAN.

On the 24^{th,} December 2020, the Association received a formal response from the WSC relating to submissions submitted via the Golden Beach Town Centre Revitalisation Plan Collaboration Group.

"In general, Council does not have an objection to the proposals in the Golden Beach Town Centre Revitalisation Plan, provided appropriate legislative, planning and compliance requirements are met"

"The Revitalisation Plan you presented had the following key areas:

- 1. New combined Information Centre and Art Gallery
- 2. Addition of showers, toilets, and laundry in an RV park amenities block
- 3. Increase the allocated RV visitor stay spots to 25 places
- 4. Rezoning proposal
- 5. Improved town signage
- 6. Beach access."

The planning and compliance requirements are quite complex and will take some time to work thru; however, we have now commenced working on both the planning and compliance requirements.

New Residential Tenancies Act requirements have meant the Association was required to make some changes for the existing RV SITE to comply. We have now made those changes to satisfy WSC re compliance with the current use and in preparation for registration as a Caravan Park under the Residential Tenancies Act. The existing RV Site, Nursery, Basketball court and future upgrades and additions will now become known as the **Golden Paradise Beach Community Tourist Park.**



The current strategic changes will now allow us to merge the new planning into existing operations seamlessly.

We are also preparing a Town Planning Application for the new Tourist Park Office Visitor Centre and Art Gallery.

ASSOCIATION PROJECTS PROGRESS REPORT

The Golden Beach Community Plant Nursery & Drinking Water Dispenser SHADE SHELTER

The Golden Beach Community Plant Nursery new shade shelter was completed the day before Christmas and now provides volunteers with significant sun, wind and rain protection. The project cost was \$10k, supported by a WSC Community Assistance Grant of \$5k.





2 PLANT SPRAY SYSTEM

A new plant shade structure has been completed and will after Easter, be fitted with an automatic spray system to reduce the watering time for volunteers.

New first stage power installed at the cost of \$1900 to the Plant Nursery site allows for an independent pump to operate and service the spray system. A daily timer operation will mean volunteers will not have to provide the watering to plants on those hot summer days.

This project was made possible by a very generous donation by the late Yvonne Harding Collis.

3 OFFICIAL OPENING

The Golden Beach Community Plant Nursery new shade shelter was officially opened by Wellington Shire Council Mayor, Councilor Garry Stephens on the 20th Of March 2021

We want to thank the Mayor and his wife for taking the time to attend and officially open the Golden Beach Community Plant Nursery Shade Shelter.





4 WATER DISPENSER

The Water Dispensing unit is now up and operating at the Plant Nursery White Wall. A new water pump and digital card payment system automatically dispensers 10 litres of water on payment by card.

There has been some criticism about the time it took to replace the old system, so we make special note:

The new unit and drinking water supplied is now provided under licence by the WSC health services (certificate for a Food Premises under the *Food Act 1984.*) Additionally, the design and system install meet electrical standards with a new power board and safety switches.

The card payment terminals and the operating panel are not an off the shelf item and were made to order and required testing and approval; we also merged a new digital site donation payment by the card system into the panel.

The complete replacement change over, including the 2nd stage, extended power installation to the white wall, cost \$3.5k and fully funded by the Association.

Our thanks to **AMEC INDUSTRIES** for assisting the Association with design and compliance issues plus providing electrical installation on time with a minimum of fuss.

Are you burning-off safely?







For many people, burning-off vegetation is an effective way to prepare and maintain properties. Unfortunately each year CFA crews are called out to help people who lost control of their burn-off.

Here is some simple advice to stay safe when burning-off.

FIRE DANGER PERIOD

You can only burn-off if you have a written permit issued by the Municipal Fire Prevention Officer or the CFA District Office.

TOTAL FIRE BAN DAYS

All fires in the open air are banned during Total Fire Ban days.
Any permits are suspended for the duration of any Total Fire Ban days.

	Have you checked your council's local law regarding when and where you can burn off?	You need to check your council's website for local laws to ensure you're allowed to burn off. Your council may have regulations and certain days that you can burn. If CFA has declared the Fire Danger Period for your municipality, open air burning is prohibited unless a specific permit is obtained. Fines for burning off during this time without a permit can be up to 120 penalty units and/or up to 12 months' jail.
	Have you checked the weather?	Check weather forecasts for the day of your burn-off and a few days afterwards. If more than light winds you should postpone your burn-off. Also check it won't be too windy on following days, as the wind can reignite your burn.
	Do you have an adequate water supply?	You need to have enough water to extinguish a possible outbreak. For small fires, it's recommended you either have access to a hose or at least 10 litres of water. For larger fires appropriate firefighting equipment and/or machinery may be required.
	Clean up around your burn site.	Create a 3-metre clearance of all flammable material around your whole burn-off site.
	Have you registered your burn-off?	Register your burn-off by calling 1800 668 511 . This will ensure CFA won't be called out unnecessarily to your burn-off.
	Have you notified your neighbours?	Ensure you are considerate of your neighbours when burning off. Notify them if you are in close proximity and the smoke may affect them. Also burning items that are wet or green may cause excessive smoke.
	Have you put it out properly?	Make sure there are enough people to monitor, contain and extinguish your burn-off safely and effectively. Ensure that your burn-off is completely extinguished

before you leave it.




