Hi to our members and the wider community

The End Of Summer Surf Festival 2023 has been again well supported by sponsors this year and it is heartening to see recognition of the event from the Sale business community even with predicted tougher times.

That is not to say that local businesses have not been supportive, our thanks to Golden Beach Real Estate for stepping up as a Major Sponsor alongside GB Energy and Wellington Shire Council.

We are also very thankful for all our local businesses who have contributed with services leading up to the event.

The challenge going forward for the Association is to complete stage one of the Information Centre and Art Gallery project after Easter.

Overall we are on track with this ambitious project and it should be noted that stage one apart from the land provided by Wellington Shire Council has <u>no</u> direct grant funding provided for its construction.

The Association has used its business enterprise skills in the first instance to pay for its construction plus a very generous individual donation of \$25k from an Artist that will provide the broader community with an asset valued at over \$70k.

In addition, we will be commencing stage two of the project, all abilities and wheelchair-friendly toilet block in the open garden area. This also includes providing an additional 10k litre water supply for Fire Fighting purposes.

It should be noted that this toilet facility is not what is generally termed a public toilet block.

It is provided for Volunteers working within the GPBCTP, visitors to the Art Gallery, and support services for St Annes Golden Beach plus support facilities for Park events.



<u>CLUB UPDATE.</u>

Dear Golden Beach and Paradise Beach Ratepayers, Residents and Visitors.

This is just an update on where the Surf Life Saving Club is currently at -

The Club has applied to Life Saving Victoria (LSV) for affiliation. Due to public concerns and feedback LSV is now more receptive to the establishment of new Life Saving Clubs along the foreshores of Victorian waterways. Due to the number of drownings and aquatic accidents that have occurred over the last couple of years, the public feedback and support, has been for the establishment of new clubs. LSV has established a 3 stage process for affiliation applications. The first step is to make application (this has been done), the second step is to be granted Probationary Affiliation, after meeting with LSV, and the final step is full affiliation. No time-line to reach the final step has been articulated, but this will be granted when LSV believe the club is ready to meet all criteria and requirements. One very important criteria we will need to show is full support from the local community.

Burning off in Golden Beach, Paradise Beach & Surrounding Communities

RESIDENTIAL ZONES:

If you live in or are visiting these areas YOU WILL require a permit to burn off on your property at any time of year. You **must** be able to demonstrate there is no alternative to burning, that smoke is unlikely to cause a nuisance to your neighbours and that the burn can be conducted safely.

During CFA Declared Fire Danger Periods

All permits to burn are issued by CFA

To obtain a permit for any kind of burning you must apply directly to the Country Fire Authority (CFA) by visiting <u>CFA Permits</u> or by contacting CFA District 10 in Sale on (03) 5149 1000.

During Non- Declared Fire Danger Periods

Permits to burn are issued by Wellington Shire Council

To apply for a permit to burn, fill out a Local Laws Permit Application Form and submit it to Council. If you are unsure of your property zone, you may obtain a free report online. Visit: www.wellington.vic.gov.au/community/fire

You **must** be able to demonstrate there is no alternative to burning, that smoke is unlikely to cause a nuisance to your neighbours and that the burn can be conducted safely.

Standing Requirements for Every Burn

- Ensure that local fire services are aware of your burn by phone 1800 668 511 or
- Email the Burn Off Notification Form to <u>burnoffs@esta.vic.gov.au</u>.
- Let your neighbours know at least 2 hours before starting a burn.
- Check weather conditions do not burn if wind exceeds 10 km per hour (light breeze) or temperature exceeds 32°C.
- Make a fire break by clearing at least 3 metres of flammable material from around the burn area.
- While the burn is alight, ensure you have enough people and water on site to control and extinguish the burn safely and effectively.
- If you fail to meet these requirements you may incur a penalty.
