Our Association in November 2023 received a report from WSC Councilor Marcus McKenzie re: green projects being proposed for the Gippsland region.

We have carefully looked at those projects that appear to have some impact on Golden Beach. It must be stated that there will be projects not looked at as they grow each day change names/ownership and have very complex impact outcomes that will not become public until Governments approve licences.

What we have done is to ensure that our Community has direct consultation with these emerging and proposed ventures. We believe it is essential where possible that residents and or property owners have the opportunity to get information directly from the horse's mouth. We have directly reached out to some of these Companies and Agencies to remind them that they have both a moral and legal obligation to talk and inform the community.

It is not the role of the association to endorse or make decisions or advise what may or may not be appropriate or acceptable to the community however, we can pursue a path ensuring appropriate consultation is or will take place regarding these projects allowing the community to make a decision and or take what action it thinks appropriate.

CarbonNet

Given that the CarbonNet project is still active we have reached out to them to engage with the Golden Beach Community and provide a clear update on the project. We have suggested that they take a different approach to the information process in communicating with the Golden Paradise Beach community.

The Association has invited CarbonNet to run an open information session during the EOSSF and has undertaken to promote it widely. Those interested parties will have an opportunity to listen and ask questions. Easter is one of the busiest times when many are down here at their holiday homes and we hope this will provide an opportunity for them to be involved.

ART GALLERY & INFORMATION CENTRE PROJECT

The contracted Electrician has completed the initial wiring install and installed the new Power Fuse Board in the Open Garden. The Art gallery will soon be connected to power from that fuse board.

Getting back into the swing now, with meetings and training commencing in mid-January. Our 3 new members are getting to the final stages of training and will have Assessments in early March -Thanks to Brendan, Cathy and Dallas for your commitment and patience over the Christmas period.

What a jam-packed weekend we had for Australia Day! Thank you to our Brigade Volunteers who put in the hard yards to help out where they could; Fishing Comp in full swing, Market BBQ, Community Education Trailer and the topper of all toppers ? a Structure Fire at the General Store!! Thank you to everyone for evacuating out quickly and staying out (I did hear that someone had snuck in for some milk though – obviously safety was not on their mind!). I really want to thank Maffra Captain and Loch Sport Captain for their quick actions in getting the Service Delivery Box under control and the power company for doing a fantastic job at repairing and restoring the power to the Shop in super quick time. I don't think I've seen Lee sweat so much; (other than during the Loch Sport Fires when he fed 4 + Strike Teams single-handedly) thanks mate, for the ice cream afterward..haha

The End of Summer Surf Festival is coming up and the Brigade will, once again, have the use of the Community Education Van at the Market on Easter Saturday.. we will have all the information on Fire Safety you require and more -- Can I or Can't I, Campfire Safety, Fire Danger Ratings, Fire Danger Districts, What to do for Total Fire Ban Days, fun things for the kids etc etc etc – we would love to see you there and have a chat.

Some Key points for everyone to keep in mind -

- Have a plan of what you will do in times of emergency have a written plan practice that plan –- discuss that plan with family, friends and neighbours.
- STICK TO THAT PLAN Last-minute changes are made in times of stress and are detrimental to your safety.
- Include pets in your plan
- Have an evacuation Kit A list of what is recommended is available
- Check on Neighbours.

Burning Off

Golden and Paradise Beach are in a Residential Overlay and CFA has advised that they **WILL NOT** be issuing any Burn Off Permits in the 2023-24 Fire Danger Period; Police <u>WILL</u> attend if property owners want to run the gauntlet.

Camp Fires

You are permitted to have a Fire for cooking and warmth with some provisos:-

- You use a built Fireplace or dig a 30cm deep Trench
- The Fire Pit should not be more than 1m Square
- Clear an area of 3m surrounding the Fire (look up, down and around) do not have your fire under trees and remove leaves twigs etc from the 3m perimeter
- Do not use flammable liquid to start the fire
- Have at least a 10lt bucket of water and a shovel nearby DO NOT COVER WITH DIRT/SAND, this will cause the fire to resurface at a later time.
- Do not leave the Fire unattended
- Supervise children and Pets at all times
- Do not burn dangerous or flammable items such as aerosol cans






