It seems just like yesterday that we were getting ready for Christmas and here we are rapidly heading towards Easter even though it is in late April.

Much has been done in the last 2 months, the Art Gallery has received its new storage facility and it is in place and ready for use.

This now allows us to connect the new Art Gallery water tank to the Nursery and Open Garden water grid, the work is programmed for immediate start.

The first stage (Information centre office Area) painting of the Art Gallery interior is currently being prepped and will commence shortly. The information internal screen is now installed with information data being loaded. This area should be operational soon subject to some minor tech installations.

The Community Plant Nursery is now undertaking the expansion of the undercover/shaded plant areas thanks to our sponsor **Dahlsens Timber Sale**. This will help expand the tube stock holdings and varieties.

We are also evaluating workplace tools such as wheelbarrows/workbenches to make volunteering more comfortable and accessible in the Nursery area.

The Open Garden area after the Easter Market Event will be closed for short periods while some structural changes and improvements are made, we apologise in advance for some action that may be at short notice.

We have received encouraging comments about the Centre Road Surf Edge Drive new Christmas Tree decorations and as such the Association will continue to provide and expand it this year. Wellington Shire Council has now placed Golden Beach on the small list of towns approved to have street decorations at Christmas.

This is part of the Associations planning to support the town centre business district to ensure existing businesses can survive and grow. The town centre is critical to the outer tourist business area such as accommodation, without facilities for tourists there are no tourists without tourists there are no businesses.

#### Golden Beach Fire Brigade

#### **Protecting Life and Property**

What a crazy Summer we have experienced – Flooding rain, some unusual snow earlier on, thunder Storms with dry Lightning and heat wave conditions. Our fire calls have been few and far between and I believe this is, in part, attributed to our Community abiding by the Fire Danger Period regulations... THANK YOU. In saying that, Summer is not over and your vigilance is still required and very much appreciated.

#### Please remember – you may have a fire for cooking or warmth only and must obtain a Permit to conduct a Burnoff 24/7, 365 days of the year.

I have been informed of a Burn Plan for the area bordered by Cooper St., Lakeline Dr., Fairway Ave. and Surf Edge Dr. Golden Beach. I believe this will take place in March/April this year and be conducted with the assistance of CFA Vegetation Management, FFMV, Parks Vic. and our amazing, neighbouring CFA Brigades. Heaps more information will be distributed as this comes to hand.

Thank you to everyone who participated or helped out for this year's Australia Day Fishing Comp. The Brigade will purchase a Thermal Imaging Camera with the proceeds from both the Fishing Competition and the Market held on Saturday. We still have Captain Koala Teddies for sale at \$20 each if anyone is interested.

Our Christmas Eve run, by and large, went really well but, some streets were missed and children disappointed. The Brigade has now decided to conduct future Santa Lolly Runs earlier in December, from a static location, possibly the Beach front Park. Presents will no longer be delivered by Santa from the Fire Truck; there are a number of contributing factors in this decision.. Christmas Eve is a time for our Volunteers to enjoy family and friends too and they should be with them; some children did not receive presents but could see others receiving them (it wasn't a nice feeling seeing this) and the safety of all Adults and Children is paramount, this is hard to do with a constantly moving Tanker. I am more than happy to discuss the Brigade decision with anyone who would like their opinion heard.



The Fund is apolitical and does not advocate either for or against these developments, as we believe change is an inevitable part of life and that communities should have an active voice in how this change happens, while sharing in any benefits that may be available.

Our goal is to engage the communities of Golden Beach and Paradise Beach in developing a shared vision for our future, building partnerships with large-scale infrastructure projects, and making sure the benefits from these projects reach the entire community in the way we all want them to.

To achieve this, we need to design and implement a community engagement program enabling renters, property owners and businesses to contribute towards creating a Community Development Plan (CDP), so that we have a collective voice that ensures positive outcomes for our community.




