Going forward the challenge for the new committee is to build the (AG) new toilet block (approx costs \$54k) and commence the development of the following new projects


- (b) Information Centre (walk-in & digital hosting)


Woohoo, Spring is nearly here and we are looking forward to some warmer weather as we undertake further re-development work and finalise peparations for the Summer Bowls Season.





Welcome to Spring,

We have had consistent use of the facilities during winter. Training days for Mental Health Awareness, Chainsaw Safety, and an accredited First Aid course were all held in the main hall. The Coastal Community Recovery Committee held their monthly meetings at the centre.

Community Consultation Sessions have been conducted by: GB Energy, CarbonNet, and Esso all in relation to offshore activities.

St Anne's Church hosted a luncheon after their service to commemorate the 20th anniversary celebrations. The Bowls Club held an indoor session when wet weather was keeping them off the green. Wellington Shire Council presented the Future Wellington workshop.

Halo Care provided 3 pop up vaccination sessions, to provide FREE Covid-19 boosters or flu vax. There was limited interest from the community. In the future we hope to encourage more health related support programs to service the community.

We are accepting bookings for training sessions to be held in September. The centre is well maintained and hirers are very happy with the venue.

Craft & book nook sessions each week have attracted extra people who enjoyed good company in a warm and friendly atmosphere. The WSC Outreach Library is well supported. Visitors to the area popped in for a chat whenever the centre was open.

Great News! Wellington Shire Council have sourced funding to have the main switchboard upgraded and a 33kva generator installed before December. This is part of the recovery and resilience plan for the centre to be a community hub after emergency events.

We are waiting for confirmation that the application for a porch to be built over the double emergency exit door has been approved through the WSC capital works program.

Maintenance is ongoing. More volunteers are very welcome. We had the uneven pavement outside the centre ground down to remove the trip hazard caused by tree roots raising the pavement.

More great news! A Grant from the Reactivating Community Facilities fund is being used to purchase two table tennis tables and equipment to be available in the main hall for casual use by the community whenever the centre is open. This is a free activity and should start in late September to coincide with school holidays. Thanks to Chris from Intersport Sale for great customer service.

<u>Craft Group</u> Through winter the group have produced knitted garments for the missions. Visitors are welcome to join the group for a social afternoon. We would like to thank all the volunteers who have donated wool to support this work. Wool is available for anyone interested in knitting for charity. Call in any Tuesday 2-4pm.



If you will be away when ballot packs are mailed, or your address has changed since Wednesday 7 August, you can request for your ballot pack to be redirected by completing the online redirection form at vec.vic.gov.au/redirections, or call 131 832.

Requests for redirection must be received by 5 pm on Monday 9 September.

Large print and braille ballot papers

Large print or braille ballot papers are available for voters who are blind or have low vision-please register by 5 pm Tuesday 10 September. To register, call 03 8620 1314 during business hours.

Early votes

If you will be away during the voting period (7-25 October), you can go to your local election office to vote in person, from 10 am on Wednesday 18 September.

How to nominate as a candidate

To nominate as a candidate, you must:

- · be an Australian citizen and enrolled on the voters roll for Wellington Shire Council AND
- · be eligible to become a councillor should you be elected AND
- have completed the mandatory candidate training before lodging your nomination with the election manager.

To nominate, complete the nomination form and lodge it with the election manager together with the \$250 nomination fee. Nomination forms can be lodged by appointment during business hours from Monday 9 September until 12 noon on Tuesday 17 September at the election office.

Visit vec.vic.gov.au for more information and to pre-complete your nomination form using the online Candidate Helper. The online Candidate Helper will be available from Tuesday 20 August.

If you use the online Candidate Helper, print your pre-completed form and make an appointment to lodge it with the election manager along with the nomination fee.

Call the election manager from Monday 9 September on 131 832 to make a nomination appointment.

Nominations close 12 noon Tuesday 17 September.


