The Association has been extremely busy all year however, the last leg of the journey has been a thriller.

Like every year everything you start you try to finish before Christmas and try as you may it gets no easier.

A lot of projects are dependent on obtaining a grant to assist in getting them off the ground, getting the grant in the first instance is difficult and takes a lot of time and patience.

What most people don't know is that after the project is completed the grant if there is one has to be signed off which requires extensive reporting including financials and PS you don't always get what you ask for as the Grants area is highly competitive.

THIS YEAR

On top of managing 7 grant applications, we have finalised a town planning application and submitted a Building Permit Application and plans to start the new Art By The Sea Gallery & Welcome Information Centre with stage one now contracted. Also, Mini Art markets have now started up to get the mood going.

Due to the rising costs on all fronts, we have been forced to split Stage 2 (New external Toilet Block) into two separate components and commence fundraising to fill the growing gap of approx \$20 thousand, and while some would ask how much does a toilet cost? it should be noted we are required to provide a facility that is all-abilities and wheelchair-friendly and includes access to and from the area.

GONE WITH THE WIND

The hot house featured in last edition was doing well up to the end of November when the big winds came through and absolutely wrecked it, fortunately we did not lose any plants.

We always took the view that the structure was only short term until a dedicated hot house structure was built with wind protection provisions along the fence, just didn't figure it would be such a short term.

We are now looking for about 20 lengths of structural pine timber in 6.2m lengths to get the new hot house started, if anyone can assist we would be most grateful.

The rest of the Plant Nursery is now looking good, we have some good stock available and ready for planting.

We are now able to obtain the tree that many have enquired about.

At the entrance to the Plant Nursery, we have a beautiful tree growing called ADONIS FLEXUOSA (BURGUNDY)

For a short time only we have access to well-advanced stock as shown in the picture right.

These lovely trees won't take long to make your garden a delightful sight, however, they are priced to take into account for their advanced growth.
