

VMMR Annual Aggregate Trophy


Each summer the VMMR sponsor the Bowls Club Champion Aggregate prize. This year the winner is Murray Bodsworth.


The Community Nursery Is Open Every Saturday Morning 9.30am to 12.30pm (Subject to Weather Permitting)

The Brigade has been quiet (look out – I've said the "Q" word) over Autumn with just a couple of support calls to help neighbouring brigades.

Our Elections were held in April and all Office positions remain the same – Paula Grosveld, Captain, Gerry Wassink, 1st Lt., Colin Price, 2nd Lt., Leanne Dempster, 3rd Lt. & Secretary. Linda Doward is in the position of Brigade Community Safety Co-ordinator. Some of you may have met Linda at the End of Summer Surf Festival while she manned the new CFA Community Education Van. Thank you to everyone who came to the Van for the updated information.

As part of Linda's role, she has asked that the following be included as a reminder to our residents who may be thinking of doing a bit of clearing:-

The Townships of Golden/Paradise Beach require a "Permit to Burn" all year round. Call **Wellington Shire** on **1300 366 244** if you are unsure of how to apply. Providing your application is successful, (there are stipulations) a permit is usually issued within 10 working days. (You cannot ring Friday and hope to get a Permit for that weekend)

Once you obtain a Permit, **Register your burn**, no matter how small, with the **CFA Burnoff Notification Line – 1800 668 511**. The Brigade may be called if you do not register. Volunteers regularly stop what they are doing to turn out to unregistered burns.

Always monitor weather conditions – what is the forecast for Today, Tomorrow and the next day – is it safe for this whole period?

Have you cleared a 3-meter perimeter around your intended burn?

Do you have a plentiful, easily accessible water supply?

Do you have the means to control the burn? - Man power, rakes, shovels, buckets etc?

Do you have a **phone available**, with reception, to call **000** should you need to?

With Winter right on our doorstep, it is hoped your method of heating has been serviced and ready to keep you and your family, safe and cosy all Winter long. These would include, but not limited to:-Combustion Heater – Flue Cleaned, Fire Box cleaned and inspected for damage; Gas heater – Service by a Registered professional; Reverse Cycle - Filter inspected for damage and cleaned; Electric heaters, whether Panel or Fan, the wiring must be inspected for damage and any dust and debris removed from the mechanism. If repairs are required, please seek the advice and services of professionals




