Golden/Paradise Beach 2018/19 Holiday Rubbish Collection

Locals and visitors to the Golden/Paradise Beach region are advised of an improved rubbish collection and cleaning service during the 2018/19 summer holiday period.

Wellington Shire Council is working collaboratively with Parks Victoria and the Gunaikurni Land and Waters Corporation (GLaWAC) and the Golden Beach Residents and Ratepayers Association to plan for the upcoming holiday season.

The aim of each organisation is to provide open, safe and clean facilities, along with adequate rubbish and litter collection.



Camp Rubbish

Camp rubbish collection along Shoreline Drive increased to 4 days per week during Peak Season
Administered by: Parks Victoria/GLaWAC, jointly funded by Wellington Shire Council



Toilets

Increased cleaning and servicing of Public/Camp toilet facilities during Peak Season
Administered by: Parks Victoria/GLaWAC and Wellington Shire Council



Litter Bins

Will now be emptied 5 days per week (including weekends) during peak season
Administered by: Wellington Shire Council



Household Bin Collection

This service will remain unchanged for residents over the holiday period
Administered by: Wellington Shire Council
