

The All Too Common Denominators

Many are confused about Christianity and wonder how they can even know what Christianity actually is due to the tens of thousands of denominations worldwide. Yet whether we're talking about denominations labelled as Christian or churches labelled as non-denominational Christian churches, there are several common problems among modern churches which misrepresent Christianity. It is hard to find a church today without at least one of the following errors. The vast majority have several. These are some key examples of how darkness masquerades as light by presenting a cure to the ultimate disease of sin which not only is ineffective, but can even potentially make it worse and hinder those affected by it from seeking the authentic cure which will bring them into the way of righteousness, save them from the wrath of God, and ultimately deliver them from eternal damnation.

Unconditional Security Doctrine: This goes hand in hand with the OSAS (once saved always saved) concept which tells people that if they've ever been a partaker of Christ they can never ultimately fall from grace. True Biblical salvation on the other hand remedies man's rebellion against God and never promises salvation to anyone who is heeding the ancient lie of the serpent that we can transgress against God and "not surely die" (see Genesis 3:4 & Romans 8:13). It is no wonder that so many churches are plagued by immorality, lusts of the world, lukewarmness, and hypocrisy. Their very own doctrine offers God's grace without emphasizing our need to turn from the disobedience we need His pardon from and prove ourselves as His faithful subjects whom it would be fitting to have in His kingdom for eternity. (Rev 21:8, Rev 22:14, etc) Judas was hand-picked by Jesus Himself to be one of His Apostles- and yet he turned and fell away from Jesus to his own damnation. Are you greater than God's Angels who fell away and are reserved in chains under darkness to eventually burn forever? (Jude 1:6)

Lack of Preaching on God's Wrath and the Fire of Hell: The God of the Bible sent a flood which killed everyone on earth besides eight people who were righteous before Him, He destroyed Sodom and Gomorrah with fire and brimstone, and He has done many other terrifying acts as examples to preview and warn us of the severe eternal judgment which He will bring to those who are transgressors in His sight. God is holy, God is wrathful, God is a consuming fire- but few churches want to spend much time dealing with this. They know preaching God as He is, a Great King who ought to be feared, will not be good for business. (Proverbs 27:5-6, 1 Timothy 5:20, Ecclesiastes 7:5)

Church as a Business: Though the Bible teaches that there is a rightful place for church leaders to be recompensed financially for their labor, church is not supposed to be a business which one plans to make a career out of and use as a means of financial security and material comfort. The fact that most church leaders see church as a business is proven by how they do not faithfully teach and enforce even the Bible truth that they know. This isn't even considering their lack of openness to correction and more light concerning what faithful Christianity entails in God's eyes. They KNOW such would cause them to lose membership- and thus lose income, which is of course their principal aim. Jesus Christ showed a great display of His anger in His public ministry when He cast the money-changers and merchants out of the Temple of God. These are the spiritual ancestors of Christendom's clergy class today. (John 2:15-16, Jude 1:4-6)

Prosperity Gospel and Birthright Privileges: It is no wonder then that man's happiness and prosperity is often inordinately spoken of and Scripture is twisted to justify this. And it is no wonder that many of the most popular preachers now are Prosperity Gospel preachers. People are taught that God owes them because they are (supposedly) Christians and they (supposedly) have the privilege to claim from God whatever their heart desires. It is no wonder also that the nation of modern Israel is blessed in the majority of churches with the assumption that its present prosperity must be a sign of God's favor. Likewise, since the emphasis is on what God owes man and not on what God requires of man, unconditional security is usually taught in the same churches as a form of birthright privilege. As they claim the Jew who rejects Christ hasn't lost God's favor, the so-called born-again Christian (they claim) is in God's favor due to the status he may have had at some point in the past. The truth though is that Jews who reject Jesus Christ, and the modern nation of Israel mainly composed of the same, are under God's wrath; and likewise the professing Christian who doesn't abide in Jesus Christ and bring forth the fruit of righteousness through Him is also under God's wrath. (Romans 11:21-22)

Entertainment and Emotionalism: Rather than doing God's business and seeking to be pleasing to Christ, the trend in churches is to entertain man and to satisfy him emotionally. Music that emulates the world's music, elaborate sound systems, concert environments, carnal hype, and fun rule the day. No honest person acquainted with the Bible could imagine its faithful men so catering to the demands of the Pagan society around them. But actually, it was unfaithful church leaders doing this very thing which caused the corruption in the early Christian churches and led to the decline of the holy testimony that was established by the churches which Christ's Apostles founded. (2nd Peter Chapter 2, Jude 1)

Yoking with the Roman Catholic Church: The harlot church which was, and still is the chief product of the compromise between Christian churches and Pagan society is not called out as being such. It is rather emulated in its compromise to a significant degree; and quite often it is justified and involved in interdenominational fellowship of some kind. The current Pope is only a manifestation of the blasphemy, deceit, and fornication with the darkness of this world which his office and church have represented since at least the 4th century AD. (1st Timothy 2:5)

Fake Long Hair Hippie Jesus: Even though many acknowledge that the image whereby Jesus is commonly portrayed in modern times must be false for obvious reasons, the modern churches seem to be the slowest to get this. That must have something to do with how the soft, effeminate man with long hair is much more compatible with the above points than a holy, masculine 1st century Jewish man with short hair. The modern jesus is an idol and a counterfeit of the real Jesus. We are warned in Scripture to be aware of fake jesuses and to not bear with them (2 Cor 11:3-4). Having a salvation that is real, and not counterfeit, comes only by believing in and obediently following the true Jesus of the Bible who is "the true God, and eternal life." (1 John 5:20b)

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Jezebel Spirit: Often the Bible's prohibitions against women spiritually leading and teaching men in the church are blatantly disobeyed. Even more often the Bible truth that the wife ought to be subject to her husband is mocked while men who try to instill reasonable rules and order in their homes are labelled as harsh and unloving. Women lecture men in and out of church, flaunt their bodies in immodest clothing, wear make-up, and are feared by male church leaders if they should think about preaching about how wrong any of this is in God's eyes from the straightforward instructions of Scripture. Men who do their duty and appropriately exercise their God-given strength in any form are labeled as harsh, unloving, unchristlike, and are lumped in the same category with men who are truly abusive.

An Epidemic Destroying the Soul of America and the Souls of its Citizens

The Bible says in 1 Corinthians 14:8 "For if the trumpet give an uncertain sound, who shall prepare himself to the battle?" There is a prevalence of a strain of great evil in our nation that is not derived from the corrupt politicians, nor the ultra-rich oligarchs who have in a very deliberate way sold their souls to the devil for money, power, and pleasure. Nor is this segment of evil necessarily found to a significant degree in the base levels of our society among the hardened criminals who are either locked up in prison or at least ought to be. The previously mentioned strains of evil are doubtless strengthened by, and benefit from, what we are considering here. Nevertheless this particular strain is much more dangerous because it is cloaked in righteousness, it is much more compatible with any aspect of virtue, and because it is something which the common person who avoids the most heinous and degraded expressions of evil can still be exposed to and partake of. And most dangerous of all, its very vehicle of transmission is a compromised form of the Christian faith which in its pure form is the very cure for the evil in man's soul.

The Bible warns in 2 Timothy 3:1-5a "This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come. For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, Without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good, Traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God; Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof..." Yes, the Bible itself warns that in the last days there will be a prevalence of a form of godlessness (i.e. a form of Christianity) which denies the very power of Christianity and leaves those infected by it in their sins. Most professing Christians know and believe that salvation from sin and justification before God are available through Jesus Christ's death and resurrection. And most (but amazingly not all) will say that believing in Jesus doesn't give a person an excuse to live like the devil. Yet despite this, most also have accepted a gospel where unwavering obedience to the commands of the Bible and a wholehearted forsaking of all forms of sin are not a necessary ingredient of Christianity required for an individual to actually inherit salvation through Jesus Christ. The compromised gospel preaching from our pulpits, radios, tvs, etc have caused an uncertain sound to be made which has not expressly and unmistakably called people to wholehearted repentance from sin and faithful Christian worship and living. Nevertheless, over and over the Bible reiterates the need for this and emphasizes certainly and emphatically that Christ's death and resurrection will profit us nothing without it. This straightforward, general Christian truth is not often stated; and even if it is, it is often quickly modified or negated. You just have to listen to the preaching and see the examples of the membership of most churches to know that this is so.

Imagine the heroes of Scripture permitting a bit of corruption here and there where they had jurisdiction.

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Imagine John the Baptist telling his audience that dabbling in sin now and then wouldn't affect their salvation, maybe telling the tax collectors they could cheat the people they really didn't like, maybe telling the soldiers they could commit extortion when they really needed money, or maybe telling the people that giving their surplus for the poor and needy was a good option, but not something God actually required. Imagine Abraham partaking in, or even justifying at all, the gluttony, sloth, lasciviousness, and pride of Sodom. Imagine Moses keeping the Golden Calf around and letting the Israelites dance sensually in scant clothing as if God were not totally holy and shouldn't be feared too much. Imagine the Apostles Peter, John, and Paul receiving famous Romans into Christian churches who hadn't completely broke off from their heathen idolatry, customs, and entertainment. If you can imagine such, you definitely need to get acquainted with the Bible. But if you cannot imagine any of this, it is logical to drop any excuses and any theology you may have which holds you back from applying the obvious to your own life and the choices you make on a daily basis. Is not Jesus Christ the same now and forever as He was in Bible times? Of course He is! "What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? God forbid..." (Romans 6:1-2a)

Sports News

5-fold increase in sudden cardiac deaths of FIFA players in 2021

The Israeli Real-Time News reports from December 2020 - Nov 2021: 183 professional athletes and coaches have suddenly collapsed! 108 of them died! According to the literature, the phenomenon of collapsing athlete breakdown for reasons unrelated to injury is rare. We don't have to read into this to see what the common denominator is. These athletes are in top shape and the increase in collapse and death is absolutely staggering.

- Most athletes are males (only 15 females)
- The vast majority are 17-40 years. Only 21 are older (5 aged 42-45, six aged 46-49, 7 aged 51-54, and 3 others aged 60-64).
- 23 are teenagers, aged 12-17, 16 died.
- In most cases, it has been reported that the cause of the collapse is heart-related, including myocarditis, pericarditis, heart attacks, or cardiac arrest.
- The second cause reported is clotting events.

Many dozens of cases were removed as full details were not provided so only the cases that were reported in detail were included. In addition, cases were removed in which evidence of previous risk factors was mentioned, such as a cardiac disease or diabetes which of course are rare in professional sports.

Finally, 5 international soccer stars from different countries were reported to have died after suffering sudden heart attacks the last couple weeks of December 2021. Are these deaths linked to the COVID jabs? Are there any other explanations? None we can see!

The Bible: A Self-Defining Book

Though living by the Bible can be excruciatingly challenging, the Bible's instruction is sensible and reasonable. The Bible makes extreme analogies and contains passages which are hard to understand, yet when all the evidence is reviewed it's perfect in every aspect. The God who inspired it isn't the author of confusion. Here are a few examples of how the Bible can be rightly understood by an honest consideration of the whole to interpret things in it which might be misunderstood otherwise.

1) "Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself." (Matthew 6:34a) Does this mean that we should never make any preparation for the future? No. Anyone who reads the verse in its context will see the point is we should never let concern over the future prevent us from doing what is right before God today. Having that as our supreme priority is the most important preparation for tomorrow because God takes notice of who really trusts Him and especially cares for their needs. 2) "For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you" (Matthew 6:14). Is this saying that we can get away with sin if we simply forgive others? No. Is it saying that we have to be more merciful than God Himself by forgiving those who are unrepentant about harming us? No, the very next verse and the parable Jesus told later in Matthew 18:21-35 make it clear that we will surely not be forgiven if we don't show mercy to others in the way that we need God to be merciful to us. We must have a readiness and willingness from the heart to forgive those who've wronged us when they are contrite and willing to prove their repentance by their deeds. 3) "And if thy hand offend thee, cut it off: it is better for thee to enter into life maimed, than having two hands to go into hell, into the fire that never shall be quenched: Where their worm dieth not, and the fire is not quenched." (Mark 9:43-44) Should we cut off body parts involved in sin? Jesus said this expecting us to use common sense to know that cutting off a body part isn't going to remedy any problem with sin we have. He meant that we should go to whatever length necessary to renounce our sin from the heart and to discipline ourselves to walk right before God. Doing so may actually require that we give up our television, computer, and/or smartphone- that's almost as extreme to many as cutting off a body part! From a different angle, Jesus said in another passage: "For what is a man profited, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul?" Whatever rejection from friends or family or crowd we value, financial loss, missing out on fun, disappointment, discomfort, etc that we need to endure in order to be faithful to Christ and strive against sin will surely be worth it in eternity for those whom God deems faithful!
