Since September of 2019, Australia has been experiencing devastating bushfires. At least 28 people have been left dead and 3,000 homes have been destroyed since the fires started. The bushfires are usually started from natural causes such as lightning strikes. However, according to the Sydney Morning Herald, New South Wales police have charged 24 people with purposefully starting the bushfires. While wildfires there occur year-round, during their warmer months Australia goes through a fire season because of the hot temperatures. The dry weather and winds make it easier for fire to spread. An occurrence called the Indian Ocean Dipole, which is when western Indian Ocean waters become warmer and the eastern waters of the ocean becomes colder, has the effect of pushing rainy weather away from Australia. The Indian Ocean Dipole is happening now, and without the rainy weather in Australia, it is going to be more difficult to calm the fires.

Australia's bushfires has taken an enormous toll on wildlife, with a huge number of mammals, birds, insects, reptiles, and other species killed. It is estimated that more than a billion animals have been killed because of the fires. The state of New South Wales has been affected the worst, with over 12,355,269 acres of land burned and destroyed. Fortunately, firefighters from the U.S, Canada, and New Zealand are there trying their best to help. Hopefully, the fires stop soon. In the meantime, please pray for Australia and donate to charities supporting the cause if you can.

- 2 ½ cups of marshmallows

- Pour batter into prepared crust.
- Bake for 40 minutes.
- Top with marshmallows.

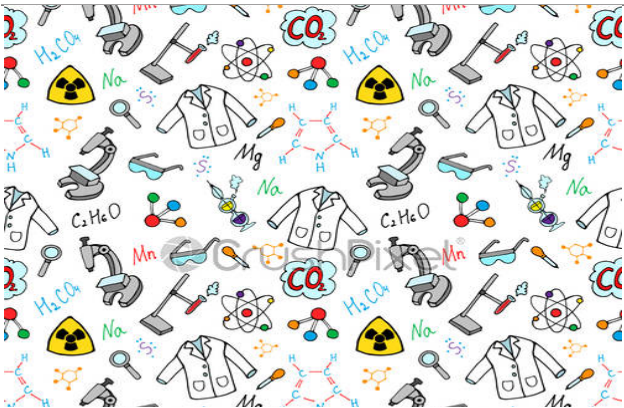
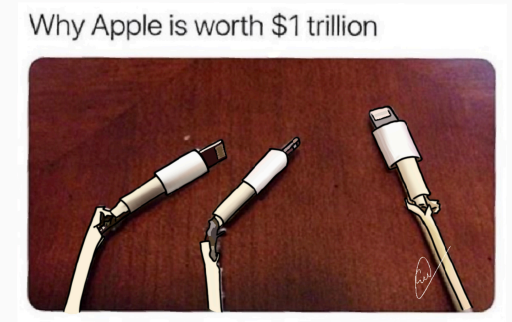
