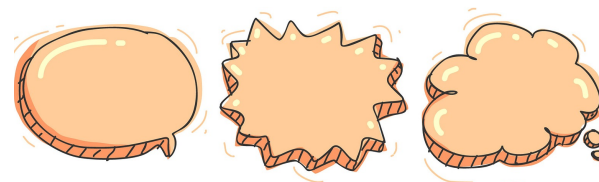

When we ran a trick play and the coaches didn't find out.

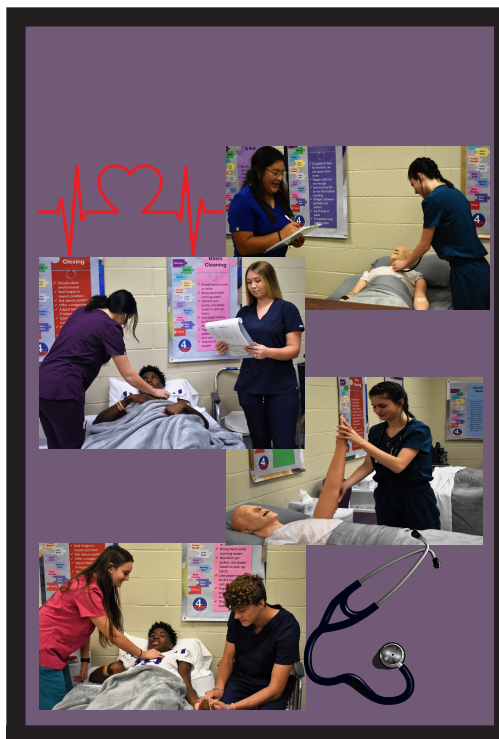

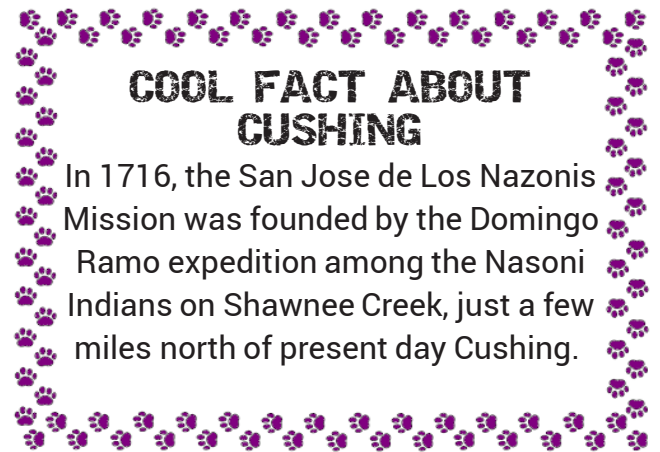


REGION 7 REUSE COMPETITION

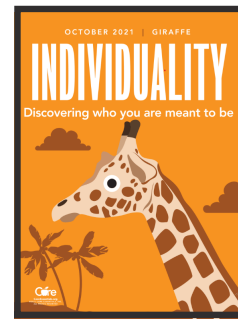

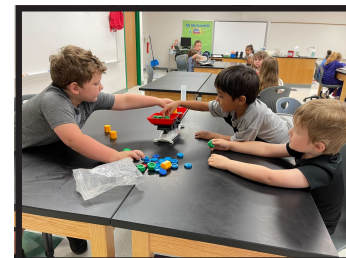


COOL FACT ABOUT CUSHING

The first show is at 2 p.m. and the second show is at 6:30 p.m.

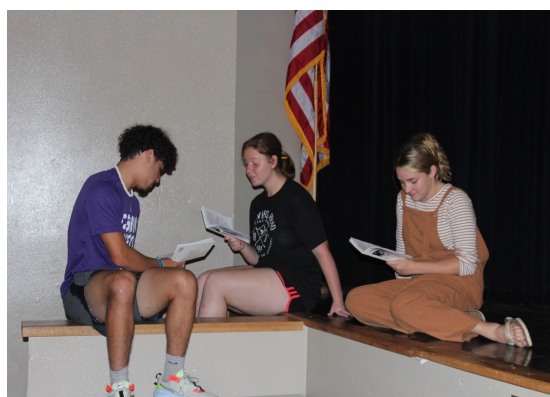

Children (elementary and younger)-\$10

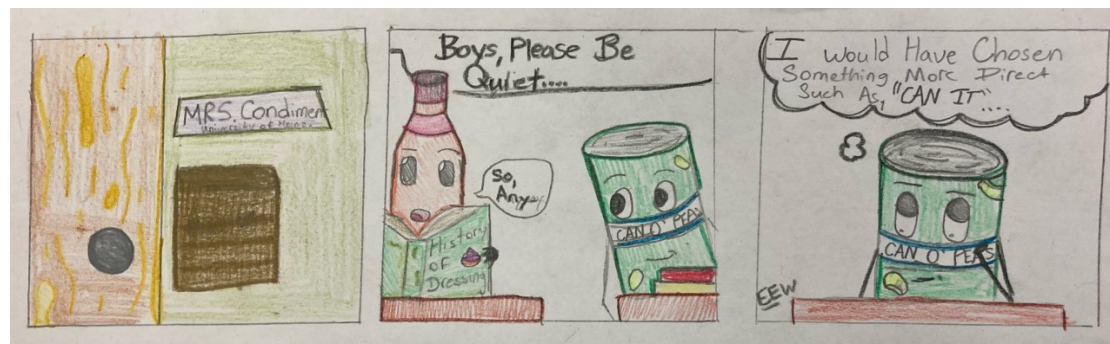
