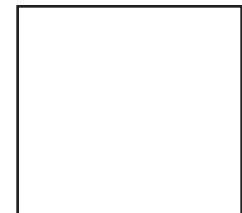

Rodeo Family Steps Up to Help Fellow Cowboys



In the past month, a few members of our rodeo community have experienced some serious accidents and ailments -- and our rodeo family has stepped up in a big way to assist these folks in their time of need. It is amazing what can be accomplished when we are all working together toward a common cause! Here are some updates on these situations:

**Hal Coburn** underwent surgery in March to remove the lower portion of his right leg after complications from an infection in his foot. He is now at home and waiting for his prosthesis to be fitted so he can get back to doing what he loves -- announcing at rodeos and cheering on his favorite youth competitors. The rodeo community worked together using GoFundMe to raise funds to assist in paying for his extensive doctor bills and prosthesis cost, and in just a 2 week period they raised just over \$10,000.

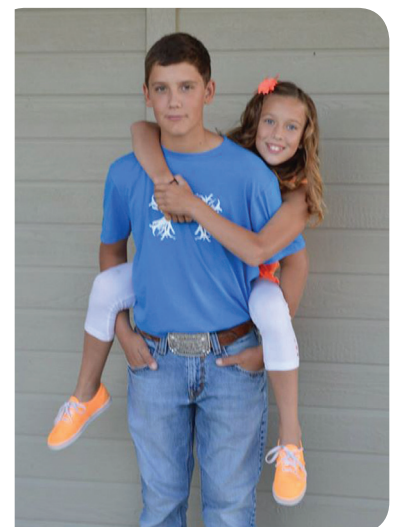
**Cole Garland** and **Connor Howard** were involved in an ATV accident, and both boys were injured when the vehicle rolled on top of them. Connor was treated and released from the hospital fairly soon after the accident, however Cole’s injuries were much more severe with damage to his spine. After spending several weeks in the hospital, Cole is now home and is working hard with physical therapy to get back to

normal. He has a long road ahead but is making a miraculous recovery in regard to the injuries he sustained. Our rodeo family, with the coordination of Niki Greenwood, held a huge yard sale to raise funds to help the Garland family with these considerable medical costs. Over \$3,000 was raised in one weekend!

**Boone Bartlome** was injured in a football accident last fall, wheelchair since that time. The rodeo community rallied behind to support him through several avenues. Bo Pickett recently held a roping event as his Senior Project; this was a fundraiser for Boone and his family to assist with anything he needs for a full recovery. ## IN MEMORIAM: TERRY REITER 1938-2015

TERRY REITER ~ September 2, 1938 – April 3, 2015

Terry Neil Reiter, of Caldwell, Idaho, peacefully passed away at his home on Friday, April 3, 2015. He was born on September 2, 1938 to Louis & Edith (Peterson) Reiter.

Terry grew up on his parent's dairy farm in Deer Park, Washington, the youngest of seven Reiter children. He knew from a very early age that he wanted to be a rodeo cowboy. As a teenager, he cut down trees that grew on the family farm, used them for fence posts and built a calf roping arena. And so began a lifetime of raising and training, winning rodeo horses.

In May of 1967, Terry married the love of his life, Peggy Daniel, in Moscow, Idaho. The two spent their lives sharing their mutual love for animals and the sport of rodeo; supporting each other in all of their endeavors.

Terry accomplished a lot in his rodeo career. He won calf roping titles in the NRA in 1968, 1969 & 1970 and was the World Champion Calf Roper in the National Senior Pro Rodeo Association three times. He nearly qualified for the National Finals Rodeo, finishing 20th in the world standings, was inducted into the Idaho Rodeo Hall of Fame and was a Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association Gold Card member. Terry won titles at countless rodeos over his lifetime, including those at Ellensburg, Calgary and Eldorado Days in Las Vegas, just to name a few. His proudest achievement was the success of the horses he trained and sold to the many cowboys to whom he mentored. Brad Carpenter won the Wilderness Circuit Finals Rodeo and qualified for the Dodge National Circuit Finals Rodeo on 'Cougar'; Jeff Coelho qualified and competed on 'Little X' at the National Finals Rodeo and Jeff Copenhaver was the World Champion Calf Roper on 'Streak'. Two of his horses placed in the first go-round at the PRCA rodeo in Salinas, California as recently as 2014.

Terry is survived by his wife Peggy; three children from a previous marriage, Bruce, Cindy and Darryl; brothers, Tom of Tacoma, and Gordon of Yacolt; numerous nieces and nephews; and an extensive family of cowboys and cowgirls that loved him dearly. He was preceded in death by his parents; sisters, Eleanor and Eileen; and brothers, Walter and Howard.

A Celebration of Life will be held on Saturday, April 11th at 1:00 at Thurman's Overtime Arena, located at 2250 Sand Hollow Road in Caldwell. # Ram National Circuit Finals Rodeo Held in Kissimmee, Florida

KISSIMMEE, Fla. - Rob and Dan Webb had a good night at the RAM National Circuit Finals Rodeo March 25 - even putting themselves in position to make a little history - and they were fairly certain their dad, Kirk, didn't get to see any of it on the WranglerNetwork.com webcast.

"You can bet he was out feeding the cattle," said Dan Webb, "taking care of the farm's 400 mother cows. Our mom (Stevia) might have watched us, but dad was pretty sure to be out there working."

That's how it has always been on the Webb farm in Wendell, Idaho. Work comes first. Rob and Dan learned their work ethic and how to rodeo from their dad, a nine-time RNCFR qualifier. Even if Kirk's not watching, he's present in their every run.

It's part of the reason that Rob, 26, and Dan, 31, have become the best team roping pair in Idaho and are now in position to make a run at becoming the first team in Wilderness Circuit history to win a title at the RNCFR. They took the first-round lead on Wednesday night with a 4.9-second run.

There is reason for the Webb brothers to draw extra inspiration from their dad these days. He had a really bad horse wreck a couple of years back and ended up in a coma. The first weeks were rough. Doctors weren't sure he was going to make it.

"But now he's back driving and working," Dan said. "It's been great."

The Webb brothers feel like they were born into their

rodeo life. They live across a hay field from each other in Wendell, practice their roping on a regular schedule while balancing farm work, developing Rob's fencing company and other endeavors.

"I was probably in middle school when we started roping together full time," said Rob Webb, "and we've just stayed with it."

They had their best year in 2014 when they finished second at the Reno (Nev.) Rodeo and split a round at the Pendleton (Ore.) Round-Up. Rob finished No. 47 among headers in the Windham Weaponry High Performance PRCA World Standings, and Dan was No. 56 among heelers.

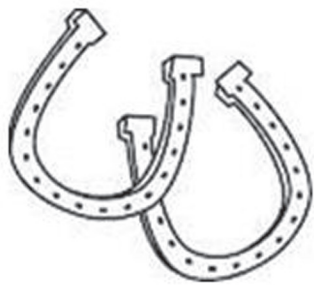

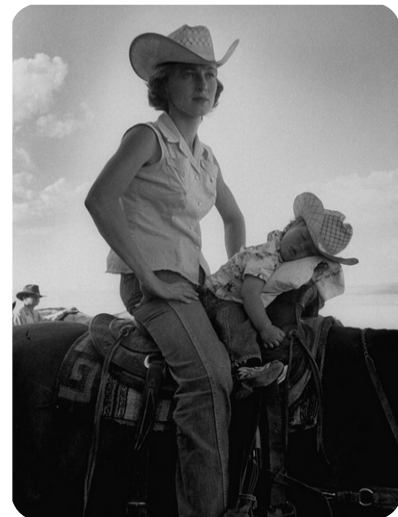
