The "Ready for our lives" project is will continue in the next school year with the meetings in Slovenia, Lithuania and Italy.

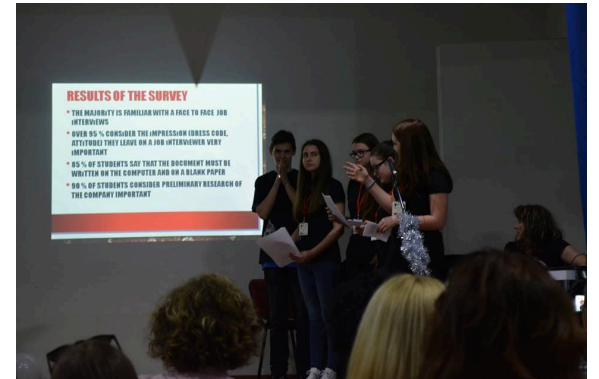
PROJECT WORK

The main topic of the meeting in Antalya was "Job interviews and Writing CV". Before the meeting about half of the students of our school, 45 students participated in the research and answered the questionnaire. Among them there were 13 students of the first form, 15 students of the third form and 17 students of the fourth form.

The questionnaire consisted of questions like "What type of job interview are you familiar with?", "Is it important what image you leave on the interviewer?", "Which of the objectives do you find the most important? but also questions about dress code, information in CV etc. The students also tried to find their strong and weak qualities. And after reading the answers we can see that the Czech students are hardworking and kind, but on the other hand also moody and shy. As the questionnaire was prepared in electronic form, everybody could also improve their IT skills. And these are also necessary nowadays!

Before going to Antalya we worked out a powerpoint presentation of the results and at the meeting Alexandr presented what we found out through the questionnaire.

We also prepared for the Day of National cuisine, we discussed what to bring or cook and we decided we would do one of our favourite things - a garlic spread. We were also thinking of potato cakes or garlic soup but it would take a lot of time, so we decided for the faster and easier way this time.

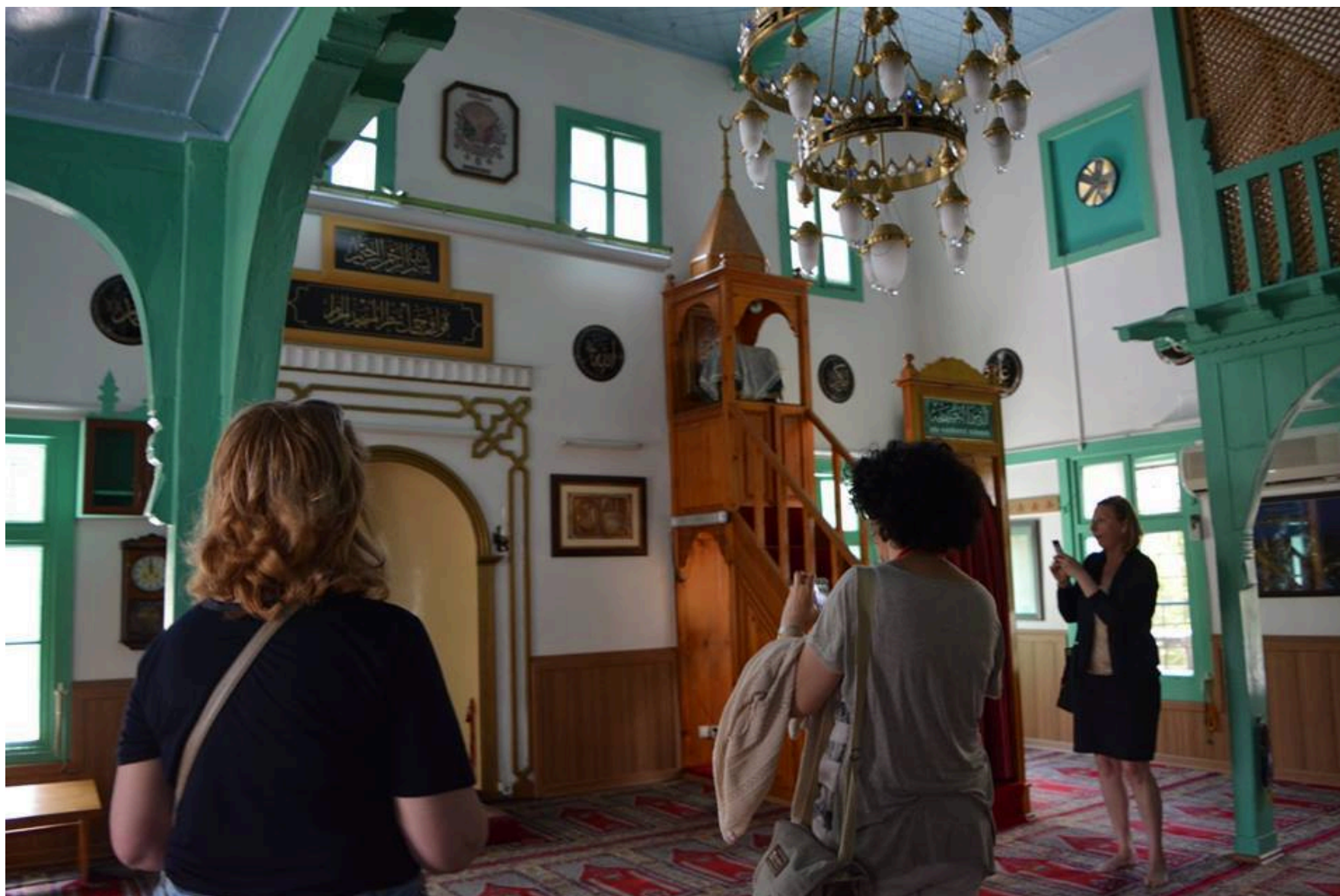
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
