**Development Centre Application Protocols**

1. Applications will be available from Racquetball Canada, posted on the Racquetball Canada website by **September 15** annually.
2. Submissions must be received by Racquetball Canada by midnight PST **October 15<sup>th</sup>** annually.
3. A Selection Committee will be struck and successful applicants will be informed of the results of their application no later than **October 31<sup>st</sup>** annually.
4. The first installment of the awarded funding will be paid no later than **November 15<sup>th</sup>** annually, and the second installment to be paid after Junior Nationals upon confirmation that all criteria are met (provided funding is available in 2019-2020)
5. Approved Development Centres must have a minimum of **1 practice per week for 30 weeks**.

**Junior Development Center Criteria**

All Centres will have a minimum of 3 athletes and must include **at least one female athlete** or a minimum of 6 athletes of a single gender.

**Funding levels for first installment:**

Centres with 3 – 5 athletes having a minimum of 1 female athlete will receive a base funding of \$300.00.

Centres with 6 or more athletes having a minimum of 1 female athlete will receive base funding of \$500.00.

Centres with 6 or more athletes of a single gender will receive a base funding of \$350.00

The Head Coach must be a member in good standing with Racquetball Canada, have a minimum of Competition Introduction certification and complete a criminal record background screen through Sterling Backcheck - [http://sterlingbackcheck.ca/cac\\_ace](http://sterlingbackcheck.ca/cac_ace) - and provide a copy of the results to Racquetball Canada.

**Funding levels/requirement for second installment:**

1. The Junior Development Centre head coach:
  - a. is Competition Introduction certified or higher;
  - b. has passed the MED module “Making Ethical Decisions”; and
  - c. has completed the online evaluation for Competition Introduction.

2. A Year End report must be submitted one month after the Junior Nationals.

Provided funding is available in 2019-2020 and once the above requirements are met, the Junior Development Centres will receive a second payment of their base funding being the remaining funds which are to be divided among the eligible development centers based on the total number of athletes attending Junior Nationals from all Junior Development Centres. (Exceptions will be made in cases of illness of injury accompanied by a Doctor's certificate).

**Formula:**

*Remainder of Junior Development center funding divided by the total number of Development Centre athletes attending Junior Nationals = base amount per athlete.*

*Final funding for Development Centres would be:*

*Base amount per athlete x the number of the Junior Development centre athletes who attended Junior Nationals.*

**Additional Funding –Coach Development**

Junior Development Centres can receive up to an additional \$100 funding specifically for coach training. This funding can be applied for after the coach, or an assistant coach attends a recognized coaching clinic and has provided the details of the coaching clinic(s) attended.
