



Doubles Registration Policy

Open Doubles at Racquetball Canada Events

1. General Criteria

- Anyone registering for Open Doubles in a Racquetball Canada event can register with or without a partner before the established deadline.
- When two players register before the deadline and designate their agreed-upon partner in the registration process, that will be considered an official team, subject to the rules for registration, withdrawal and forfeits.
- If a player designates a partner who doesn't confirm their partnership during the registration process or does not confirm their partnership with the draw master or tournament director before the registration deadline, the players will not be registered as a doubles team.
- All unpaired entrants will be partnered, if possible, with another unpaired entrant by the draw master and/or tournament director.
 - The draw master and/or tournament director will consider numerous factors, such as compatibility, skill level and the potential of future pairings when partnering players.
 - The draw master and/or tournament director cannot guarantee that all players will be paired.
- All players must be paired by the registration deadline or they will not be placed in the draw.

2. Injuries, Withdrawals & Exemptions

- If one partner is forced to withdraw from the event after the registration deadline and prior to 24 hours before the first match of the event the remaining partner has 2 options:
 - Partner with another player already in the tournament that is eligible to play.
 - Abide by Racquetball Canada's Exemption Policy that will extend to both partners of the doubles team.
