Organ Prelude: J S Bach (1685-1750) Organ Choral "Adorn yourself, O dear soul with gladness," BWV 654

Organ Postlude: J S Bach (1685-1750) Prelude in G Major, BWV 541

Adorn yourself, O dear soul with gladness, traditionally accompanies Holy Communion as a joyous feast. The familiar melody is attributed to Johann Crueger (1598-1662), and true to the first word of its title, Bach has richly "adorned" it with ornaments.

Bach's Prelude in G Major, BWV 541 springs to life with a leaping upward triad. This simple motivic cell unleashes a playful, dancing musical line. This is music of youth. In its original form, probably written around 1712 when Bach was in his 30s in Weimar.
