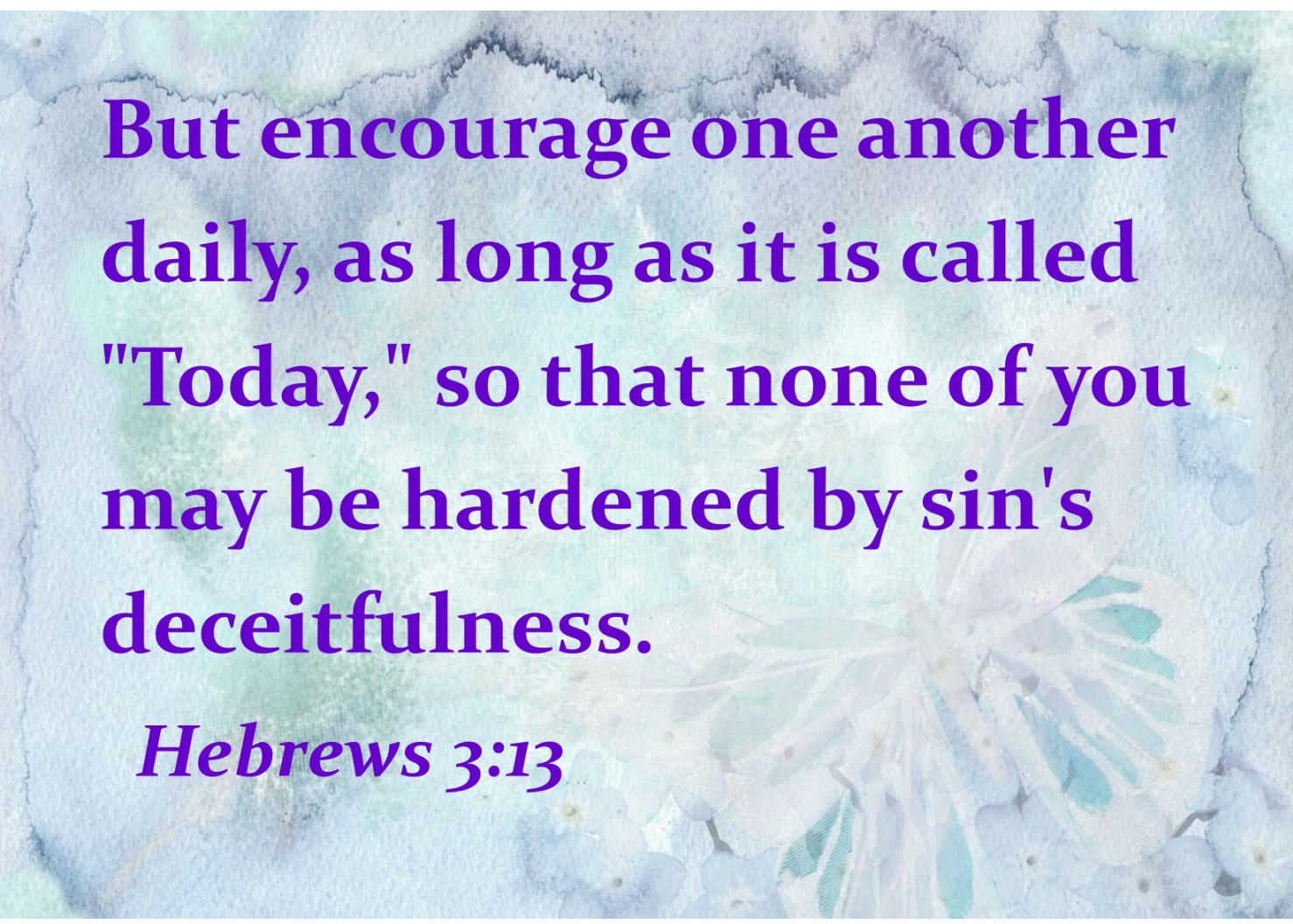

Organ Postlude: JS Bach: All glory be to God on high, BWV 664

Bach paints an amazing musical picture of Jesus sacrifice without saying a word in this second 'installment' of the Trinity in music. Here the chorale melody is not in the upper part, but in the middle (tenor), which is to illustrate Jesus as being the mediator between heaven and earth. Just before the repeat in the middle, the chorale melody rises above the upper parts for a moment, where the words refer to Jesus' heavenly dominion. Probably the most beautiful symbolism is provided by the refined ornamentation of the melody, as Bach has developed to perfection the art of illustrating the text with music. We've heard this chorale's version dedicated to Holy Spirit last week, and we will be listening to the 3rd version which is dedicated to God the Father next week.
