Prelude and Offertory: J. S. Bach - 'To God on High Alone be the Glory' BWV 662

Postlude: Leon Boellmann - Toccata from Suite Gothique, op 25

In this rendition of the 'To God on High Alone be the Glory', dedicated to God the Father, instead of a festive air Bach is choosing something more akin to a 'balm for the soul'. Perhaps the idea came from the first verse of the text: 'so that no harm can ever come to us any more'. The chorale melody is heard clearly in the upper voice, while being richly ornamented. Nothing disrupts the divine promise.

Boellmann's Toccata is until it's grand ending a pure perpetuum mobile, inspired by the Notre Dame cathedral in Paris. During his short life, Boellmann studied organ with Eugene Gigout and later taught in the organ school. He was also known for his ability 'to coax pleasing sounds out of recalcitrant instruments'.
