Through its diligent use of musical language, rhythm, form, harmony, numerology, and other compositional methods, Biblical signs are woven throughout the entire piece. In 20 variations and a fugue, Bach constructs a musical narrative of the Bible's journey through the Old Testament, the birth of Jesus Christ, his Crucifixion and Resurrection.
