Today's Organ Music

Organ Prelude: Johann Sebastian Bach: 'The old year now hath passed away', BWV 614

Organ Postlude: Johann Sebastian Bach: Prelude in E Minor for organ, BWV 548

This music continues to amaze us even after over 300 years and as Mozart once said about it: 'now there is music from which a man can learn something'.

Besides being one of the longest organ works by Bach, the Prelude and fugue in E minor is also one of the most complicated. It is especially highly valued being sometimes referred to as 'a two-part symphony'. There is nothing like it in the whole history of music.

The Prelude is a sophisticated, multi-sectional structure whose affect mirrors the gravitas implied by such a structure. As with other works in E minor, Bach explores the key chromatically.

The Postlude falls into three substantial sections, the first containing two statements of the initial theme; the second introducing contrasting manual-only episodes of dotted sequences, and the third section closing the movement with a look back at the opening material.
