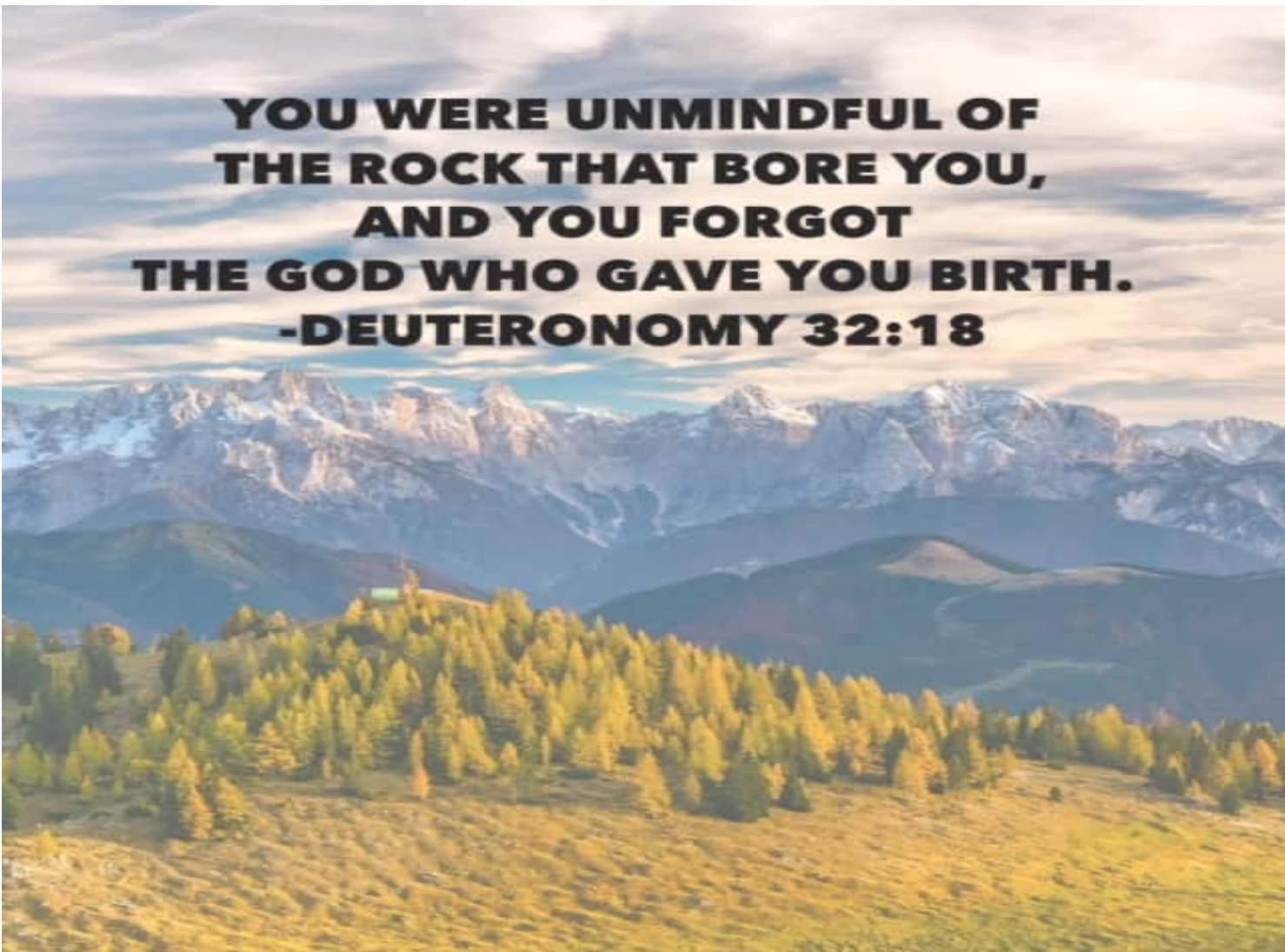

Today's Organ Music

Organ Prelude: Cesar Franck (1822-1890): Choral No. 1 in E Major for Organ p1

Organ Postlude: Johann Sebastian Bach (1685-1750): Prelude in B Minor, BWV 544 for Organ

The Choral # 1 was written during the first 10 days of August, 1890 while Franck was being looked after by friends in the country following an accident. Together with the other 2 Chorales it constitutes his musical testament. It is built around 3 themes developed as a long variation. Franck described it to his friends: 'You'll see. The 'chorale' is not the one the people suppose. The true 'choral' comes in the course of the work'. It is the most delicate and comforting theme that emerges as victorious in a glorious finale.

The Prelude in B Minor is generally considered a prayer in music, conveying not only feelings of sadness, but also of hope, optimism, and the promise of redemption.

The sadness is almost tangible in the prelude which is a deeply emotional music. Bach uses here a melancholic lament, which is followed by repetitive great leaps in the pedal, as if you have to keep reminding yourself of what has happened. Bach himself might have played this music for the first time in Leipzig on 17 October 1727.
