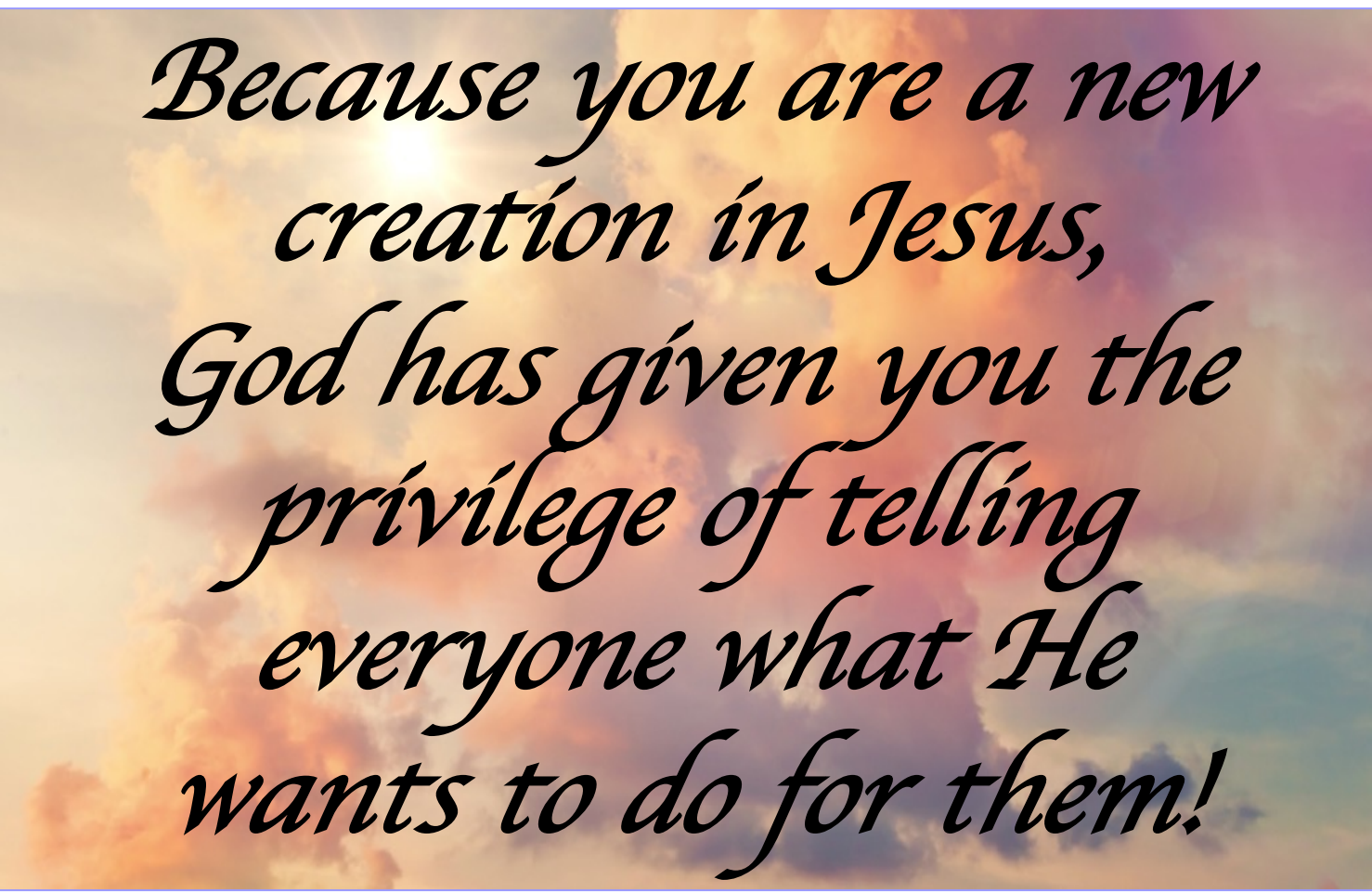

Prelude: Johann Sebastian Bach (1685-1750) – Praeludium and Trio in C Major BWV 545

Postlude: Johann Sebastian Bach (1685-1750) – Fugue in C Major BWV 545

The Prelude starts off festive and with great self-assurance. Within the first bars, the pedal goes to C, the lowest key of the pedal three times, while the right hand starts from the highest key and builds up a to a full chord.

The equally self-assured fugue is constructed firmly on the key of C major, which is never really called into question. It's end is perhaps one of the most satisfying endings for a player, as Mendelssohn (himself also an accomplished organist) was writing to his sister Fanny: "look at the last four measures: as simple as they are I feel quite in love with them and played them through for myself 50 times yesterday. How the left hand glides and turns, and how gently it dies away at the end! It pleases me very much indeed".
