Canzona in D minor, BWV588 follows early Italian models with a smooth flowing vocal style of counterpoint. The Canzona is in two sections, the second treating the theme in triple time, and it's haunting beauty is enhanced by a sorrowful theme in descending intervals.

Nicolas de Grigny, an almost forgotten French composer and organist of genius who only lived 31 years, first summated the work of his predecessors and then took it to such a development that he had no immediate successor. However Bach, who never left Germany, knew about him and copied his compositions by hand for his own study in 1713.
