Organ Prelude: Johann Sebastian Bach (1685-1750) - Trio in C Major BWV 545

Organ Postlude: Johann Sebastian Bach (1685-1750) – Praeludium and Fugue in C Major BWV 545

We are continuing our survey of Bach's major organ works with the Prelude, Trio and Fugue in C-Major. This time, in a slightly different sequence, with the Trio at the beginning of the service followed by the Prelude and Fugue played together as a postlude.

This is a music which is festive, self-assured, and majestic in character, moving relentlessly towards one of the most satisfying endings for a player (and listener alike) where all the voices are 'singing together'. No wonder Mendelssohn was writing to his sister Fanny: "look at the last four measures: as simple as they are I feel quite in love with them and played them through for myself 50 times yesterday. How the left hand glides and turns, and how gently it dies away at the end! It pleases me very much indeed". Today they will heard after around 6min30sec from the beginning of the Postlude, to reward patience and 'long suffering'.

Perhaps Bach himself could give us some insight into writing such music:

"Music is an agreeable harmony for the honor of God and the permissible delights of the soul." "I play the notes as they are written, but it is God who makes the music." "The final aim and reason of all music is nothing other than the glorification of God and the refreshment of the spirit." "Where there is devotional music, God is always at hand with His gracious presence."
