Organ Prelude and Postlude:

Johann Sebastian Bach (1685-1750): Prelude and Fugue for Organ in G Major, BWV 550

Throughout the music of J.S. Bach, G major seems to be associated with a distinct sense of joy and faith-rooted contentment. An infectious sense of joy can be heard in Bach's Prelude and Fugue in G Major BWV 550, a relatively early work written during the composer's tenure as organist at Arnstadt (1703-1707). "The sound should come bouncing into the church and sweep you along" once said an organist before playing this masterpiece. The Prelude begins with a single voice which announces its presence with childlike exuberance. Suddenly, the other voices "come out to play," piling on top of this initial statement, and launching a whimsical musical game based entirely on the opening four-note motif. The final bars of the fugue arrive at a climax of pure sunshine. The piece runs for approx 7 minutes, and I will be playing it both at the beginning and the end of the service.
