Organ Prelude, Offertory and Postlude:

J. S. Bach (1685-1750) - Concerto in A minor BWV 593 after Vivaldi, parts 1, 2, 3

Although Bach never lived outside Germany, when Vivaldi's volume of revolutionary new concertos *L'estro armonico* was published in Amsterdam in 1711, it was not long before Bach got a look at it and transcribed 6 of the 12 concerti for various instruments. For Bach, making such a transcription was an ideal way of getting acquainted with what he regarded as a new manner of 'musical thinking'. Bach's experiences with transcriptions like this one gave an important boost to the development of his own musical style as he joined up the solid German style with the Italian musical architecture, thus enriching solidity with sophistication and straightforwardness with passion.

Revelation 19:1-10

Leader: And after these things I heard a great voice of much people in heaven, saying, Alleluia; Salvation, and glory, and honour, and power, unto the Lord our God:

Congregation: for true and righteous *are* his judgments: for he hath judged the great whore, which did corrupt the earth with her fornication, and hath avenged the blood of his servants at her hand.
