Around 1730, Bach introduced a new organ genre: the trio sonata. This type of sonata, with two melodic instruments and bass, had long been in existence in Baroque chamber music, but the three parts had never been heard before on one instrument only. In this music, Bach is becoming 'personal', as he dedicates the collection for the studies of his eldest son, Wilhelm Friedemann, whom he "thus trained to be the great organist he later became". This collection represents a universe in itself, as all of Bach's mature musical language is present, including motives found in his greatest compositions. There are 6 triosonatas in this collection, each in 3 parts.

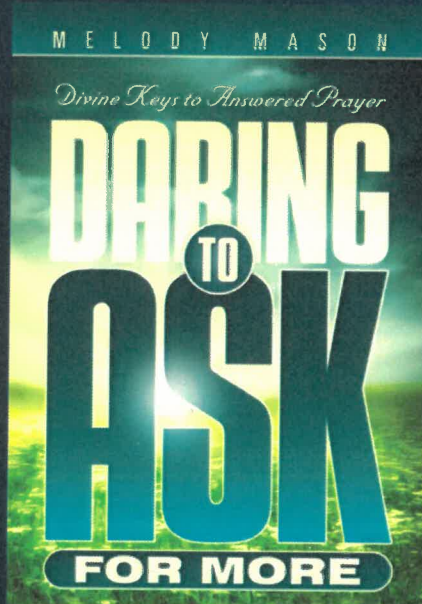

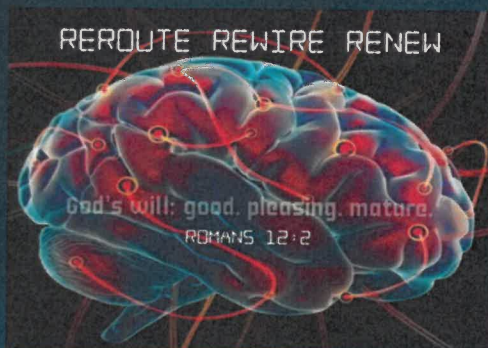

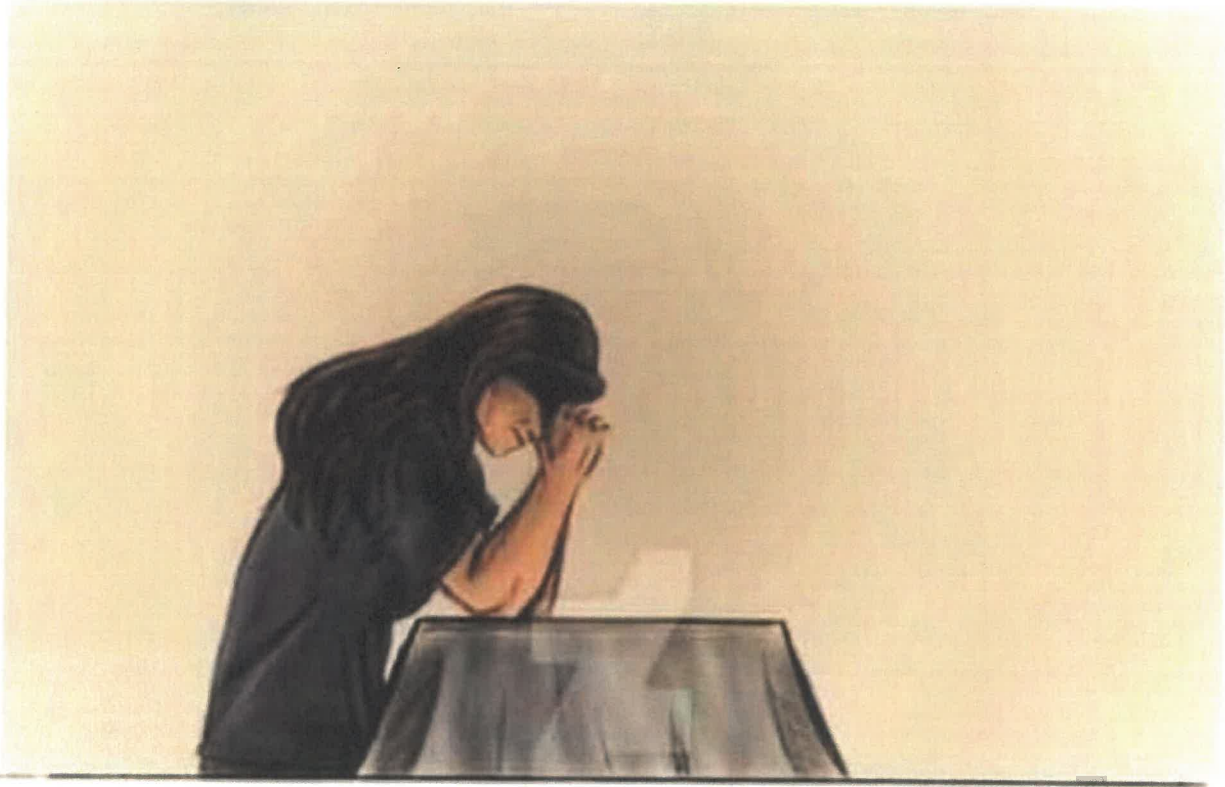
