Organ Prelude: Johannes Brahms (1833-1897): 2 Chorals from '11 Chorals for Organ': #2, and #5
Organ Postlude: Johann Sebastian Bach (1685-1750): Fugue in E Minor BWV 548 for organ

Brahms' mature art pervades the Chorale Preludes, which feature the same sort of motivic density found in the late piano pieces, at the same time paying homage to Baroque-era counterpoint. They constitute the last music that Brahms ever wrote, his musical farewell to this world, knowing that he was suffering from an incurable disease.

Albert Schweitzer described Bach's E minor fugue as "so mighty in design, and having so much harshness blended with power, that the hearer can only grasp it after several hearings." Philipp Spitta commented on the work's "life energy" and the "extreme daring" nature of the subject. Peter Williams attributed the work's "riveting power" to the "easily felt balance between it's parts." It is, doubtless, not only unique in Bach's divinely inspired music, but in the whole history of music.
