## **Organ Prelude, Offertory and Postlude:**

**Johann Sebastian Bach (1685-1750) - Triosonata in d-Minor BWV 527 p 1, 2, and 3 respectively.**

About Bach's organ trio sonatas one cannot say enough of their beauty. They were composed when the author was in his most mature period and may be considered as his chief work of that description.

A contemporary reviewer writes: "written as trios for 2 manuals and pedal, they are so beautiful, so new and rich in invention, that they will never age but will outlive all changes of fashion in music." And a different critic asserts that "pieces of this kind, when properly executed, exceed everything else in the art of organ-playing."

The feeling of the 3<sup>rd</sup> sonata is one of a beautiful, calm and nostalgic recall of one's life events, evoked by the solitude of a peaceful sunset (for the first 2 movements), ending with a song of hope pointing towards the blessing of a better future in the final part. We will hear all 3 movements today, as prelude, offertory and postlude.
