Bach's *Passacaglia and Fugue in C minor* is speaking to us in unmistakable musical and spiritual language through its diligent use of rhythm, form, harmony, numerology, and other compositional method. Biblical signs are woven throughout the entire piece. Bach constructs a musical narrative of the Bible's journey through the Old Testament, the birth of Jesus Christ, his Crucifixion, Resurrection and his glorious return to the earth. The Adagio from the trio sonata in d, is an elegant and meditative flute duet. Of note is the prevalence of the same musical material used by Bach in a previous work to describe the feelings of Simeon after having seen the Messiah ('*Lord, now lettest thou thy servant depart in peace, according to thy word*').
